I hope everyone is well. This Sunday, May 3, will be the eighth Sunday without the Mass and the Eucharist for most people. Consequently, our homes have become our domestic Churches. How we use this time will affect us the rest of our lives. How we develop a daily routine of prayer, spiritual reading, devotional practices, will change our relationship with Jesus.
