The plan is that he will be installed in Birmingham at the Cathedral of St. Paul on Tuesday, June 23, 2020.

Gaylord has Sunday Mass every Sunday at 8:00 a.m. on Direct TV, channel 33. EWTM also has a Sunday Mass. Father Michael Class and I will continue to have private Masses. Father will email it to all parishioners. It is also on YouTube. There is no Chrism Mass this year. The oils will be sent to us.

This Sunday is Palm Sunday. Palms will be blessed but given out at a later date. The Gospel is about the Passion of Jesus Christ. Please take time to read it or listen to it on the computer or TV. This is a time when our homes become places of worship.

Palm Sunday starts out with the glorious entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem. The crowds cheering and giving him homage. By the end of the week they are calling for His crucifixion. How quickly things can change.

There are many aspects of the Passion of Christ that one could elaborate on. One I would like you to consider today is Jesus' words as He hung dying on the cross. "My God, my God, Why have you forsaken me?' This is a prayer Jesus had learned years ago. It is Psalm 22. Please read verses 1-5. This is not a prayer of desperation, but of hope.
