For your information: Bishop Raica has issued a Decree in which he indicates:

- a. Suspension of public Masses and the dispensation of the faithful from attending Mass through April 30, 2020;
- b. Transfer of the date for the sacraments of initiation for adult catechumens and candidates to May 30, 2020 (Vigil of Pentecost), with associated delegated authority to celebrating priests.
- c. Transfer of the date of this year's Chrism Mass to Thursday, May 21, 2020;
- d. Postponement of the kick-off of the Catholic Services Appeal to the weekend of May 30-31, 2020 (Feast of Pentecost); and
- e. Exhortation for the faithful to pursue faith formation and maintain Christian discipleship and stewardship during this time.

Bishop concludes the Decree by noting that because the current situation that we are experiencing remains dynamic, he may modify, rescind or expand this Decree as needed to address new circumstances that arise.

Living Faith devotionals and *The Little White Book-Six minute reflections on the Gospels of Easter* are available in the vestibule on the card table. Christian books and movies are also available if you choose to take them.

- Watch daily Mass on the internet with Fr. Michael Class and Deacon Martin. Check your email. Mass can also be viewed on the TV on station EWTN.
- Come to Church and pray with our Lord. The Church will remain open. Please keep the necessary social distance from others who are praying.
- Pray the Rosary and or the Chaplet of Mercy.
- Keep in touch with relatives, friends and neighbors. Make a phone call to reach out to them and brighten their day. Pray for the intention of the weekend & daily Mass
