Good day to all,

Last Sunday we celebrated our first public Mass at 8:30 a.m. There was a total of 25 people present. It was good to see people in the pews. I can understand why some people chose not to come. We are still in the midst of uncertain times and it is wise to be cautious. Only you know your own health and what is best for you.

Today we celebrate Pentecost Sunday, the day the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles. Jesus' apostles were locked in the upper room in fear that what happened to Jesus would happen to them. They feared for their lives. Sometimes, we too, hide the fact that we are Christian, followers of Christ. We may believe, but like the apostles, lock ourselves in our own little world.

But, like the apostles, we can change and become bold. First, while they were locked in the room together, they prayed for nine days. Prayer was important for Jesus, as it was for the apostles. Prayer should be important for us as well. It was after they prayed that the Holy Spirit came upon them with wind and fire. Then, they were changed people. They had courage; they went out into the world. They spoke with confidence; they shared the message of Christ. They were empowered with the Holy Spirit.

That same Holy Spirit, promised to the apostles, is promised to us. We too can have courage, confidence, and be open about our faith in Christ. But like the apostles, we need to pray, pray diligently, pray with confidence, pray often and be open to the Spirit.

To be open means I may have to put aside some of my own ideas. I may not be able to follow all the secular ideas or what is popular. I have to re-prioritize my life. What is really important? The Spirit will guide us, to follow Him is up to you and me.
