Good day to all! Today is the Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Jesus asks, "Who do people say that The Son of Man is?" The disciples gave various answers. Then Jesus asked, "Who do You say that I am?" Peter speaks up and states, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

Jesus said to him in reply, "Flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but My heavenly Father." Peter did not come to this conclusion by reason, by studying the scriptures, by conversation with the elders, nor by his hard work. He knew this because it was revealed to him by God our Father. Some things we know by revelation and Faith.

This is the same personal question Jesus presents to us, "Who do you say that I am?" Who is Jesus to me? Only I can answer that question. Not my mother, not my father, not my siblings, not my spouse, but only me. I have an advantage knowing Peter's answer. But that is Peter's answer. What is my answer? Could I explain to another who Jesus is to me?

What would I tell them? What would I answer to Jesus? This week take some time in your prayer life to answer the question. "Who is Jesus?" Think about it. Try and put it to words. If you are a writer, write it down. Review it the next day. If you are to spend all eternity with Him, you might want to know who He is. It all begins with prayer, a conversation with Jesus. Today is a good day to expand on who Jesus is to us.

Bishop Walter Hurley, Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese of Gaylord, has announced the extension of the dispensation for all Catholics within the Diocese of Gaylord from the obligation of attending Sunday Mass through and including the feast of Christ the King, Sunday, November 22, 2020. The granting of this dispensation is not to discourage those who are able to attend Sunday Mass from doing so, but rather to enable so that anyone who needs to stay at home to protect the common good (their own or that of others) can do so confidently and in good conscience.

Bishop Hurley, has also given permission for all extraordinary ministers who need recertification by the end of November 2020, to extend their certification until the end of the liturgical year in 2021.


