Today is the Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time. Today Jesus presents the parable of a man having two sons. He asks them to go work in his vineyard. One says I will not, and the other says he will. 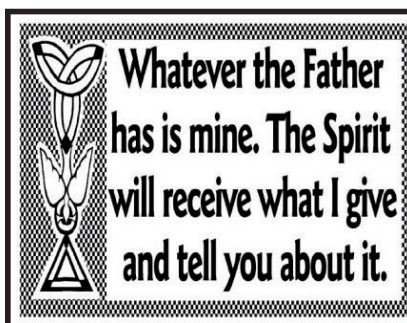


