

**Good Day to All!** This Sunday's Gospel refers to John the Baptist's Ministry and who he was. Priests and Levites came to him and asked him, "who are you? "Some Pharisees also asked him why he baptizes with water? John the Baptist responded with great humility. He was not the Christ. He was not a prophet. He "was a voice of some- one crying out in the desert. Make straight the way of the Lord." Someone greater than he was coming, someone whose sandal he was not worthy to untie.

John knew he was not the Messiah. He did not make himself something greater than who he was. His actions were not a show for the people. He did not pretend to be someone he was not. He admitted he was to prepare the way for someone greater than he, someone who he was not worthy to bow down to and touch his feet. He was in awe of this person. It was with great admiration that he was willing to announce the coming of this person.

John was given a mission from before he was born. He leaped in his mother's womb when Mary, Jesus' mother, came to visit his mother, Elizabeth. He knew his destiny was to prepare for the coming of Christ. He did this with humility.

We too, share in that mission, to prepare ourselves for the coming of Christ into our lives and in the lives of others. We do this with humility. We are not the Messiah; we are not God. We are not always right; our suggestions are not always the best. We are flawed. We can share how Christ has worked in our lives. We can help others see how God can and does work in their lives. We can help others make straight a path so they can develop a relationship with Christ, so we all can know Him better. We have the good news, God came to earth and walked among us, we must share it joyfully. We are to be alight to the world. Christianity is not a spectator sport. It is time to get off the bench and into the action!

Little Blue Books-6-Minute Reflections for Advent are available in the vestibule. Ask an usher for a copy.


Collection envelope boxes are available in the back of the Church; ushers are there to help you. Please take your envelope box. Thank you.
