

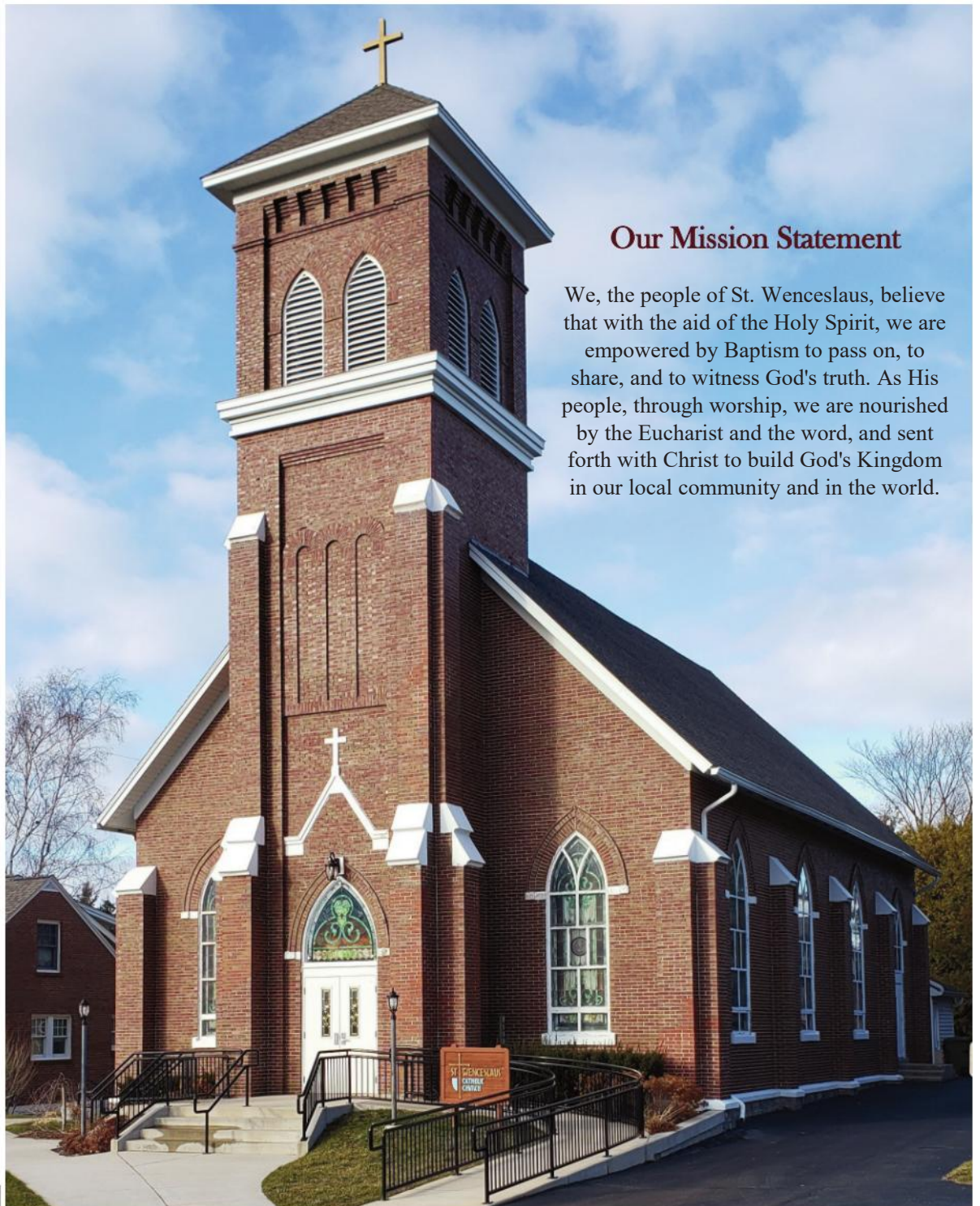

May the peace of Christ be with you all!

Today we celebrate the Second Sunday in Ordinary time. In today's Gospel, John the Baptist watched Jesus walk by, and said, "Behold the Lamb of God." John's two disciples left immediately and followed Jesus. They spent most of the day with Him. One of the disciples, Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter, went and found Peter, told him. "We have found the Messiah," translated Christ. He brought Peter to Jesus who said, "You are Simon the son of John; you will be called Cephas", which is translated Peter.

The Words John used to describe Jesus, "Behold the Lamb of God", are the same words the priest says at Mass when he presents the consecrated host and wine to us. This is the same Jesus that Andrew recognized as the Messiah, our savior. This is the same Jesus that he followed, the same Jesus who he brought his brother, Peter, to meet. Andrew got up and did something. He shared what he believed with his brother.

Do we recognize Jesus when we receive Him in Communion? Do we spend time with Jesus as Andrew did? Do we hasten to bring others to Jesus? Are we eager to share the good news with others? Do we believe enough and trust enough in Jesus to do something? To be a disciple of Jesus, we are called to action, to share what we have.

Then we, too, can say, "Behold the Lamb of God".

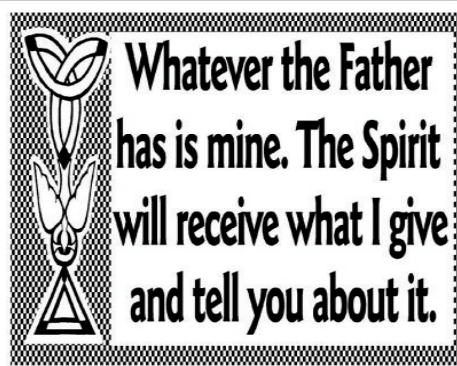


