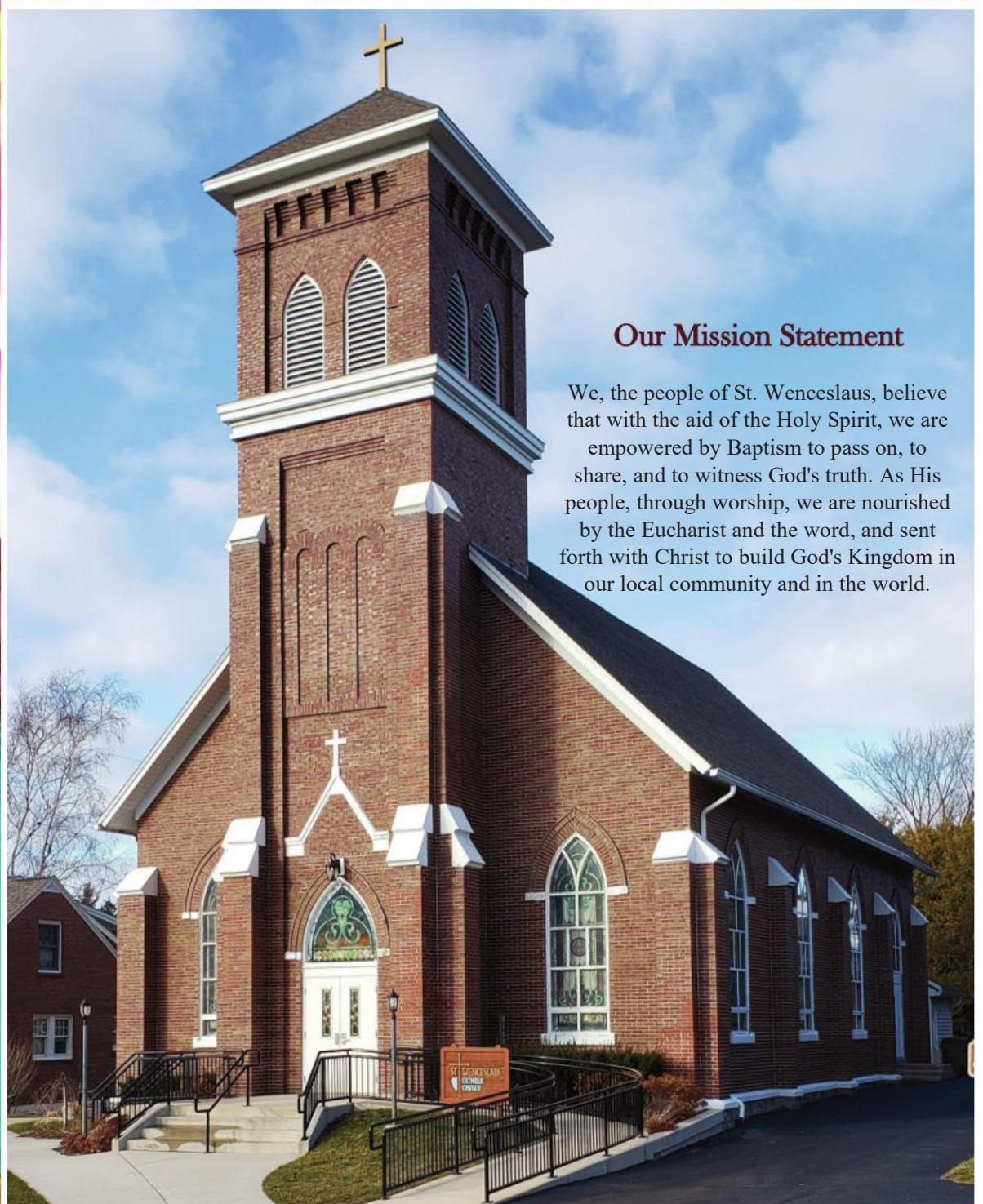

Peace be with you!

Today is the Third Sunday of Easter. In today's Gospel, Luke 24:35-48, Jesus appears to His disciples while they were in a closed room. While they were discussing the previous encounter with the risen Jesus, Jesus appeared in their midst. He said to them, "Peace be with You". They were frightened, thinking it was a ghost. He shows them His hands and feet, asks them to touch Him and asks for something to eat. They gave Him a piece of fish which He consumed. All this was to prove that He was real.

The Peace that Jesus gave to His disciples is the same Peace He wishes to give us. Peace of mind, body, and soul. This is a Peace that only God can give. This is not a peace of the world. He is not talking about the end of wars, divisiveness, hatred, riots, power grades, ... but an inner Peace that we encounter when we surrender our lives to God. Letting God be in charge, trusting in God in spite of difficulties, accepting our challenges in life, learning from them, knowing that His solution is better than anything we might imagine.

Jesus appeared to the disciples, and they did not recognize Him at first. Jesus appears to us in the Eucharist. Do we recognize Him? Do we acknowledge Him as to who He is? Do we take time with Him in Prayer, to talk to Him? Before the "Lamb of God", at Mass the priest invokes the sign of Peace. My Peace I leave you, My Peace I give you. Jesus is with us, the same as He was with His disciples after the resurrection. Jesus is in your life; do you recognize Him?

St. Gertrude Church is open for prayer at 1:30 p.m. on Fridays. If you are unable to attend, you may join by praying the rosary from home at that time.

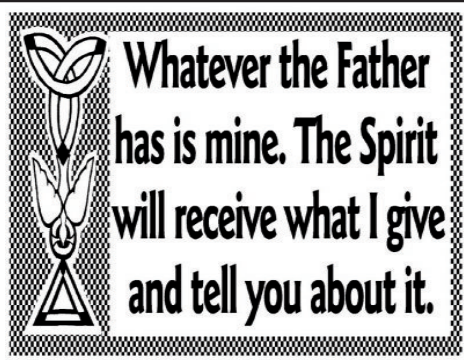

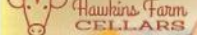
