

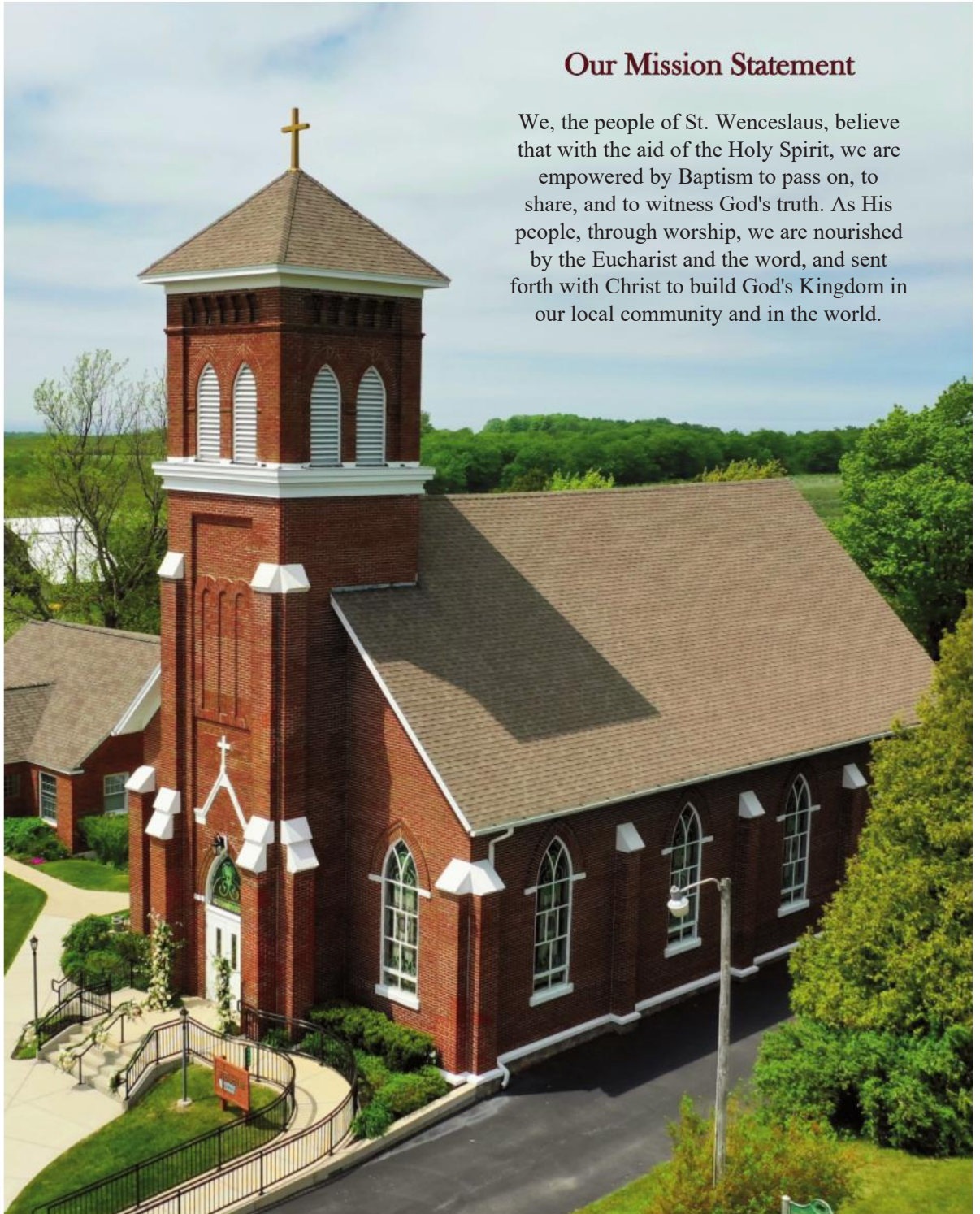

Today we celebrate the 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, *Mark 4:35-41*, Jesus and His disciples decide to cross the Galilee lake to the other side. While on the lake, a violent squall came up with waves breaking over the boat. Jesus was in the stern asleep on a cushion. The disciples became afraid that they would perish and woke Jesus. Jesus woke up and rebuked the wind and the sea saying "quiet and be still". The wind ceased and there became a great calm. The disciples were filled with great awe.

In our lives there are many things that cause us great fear. We have many worries that we have no control of. There are many sleepless nights about children, sickness, finances, the weather, my job, our friendships, the list goes on and on. We struggle with them, trying to find a solution. We seek advice from doctors, professional, even turn to drugs. We look for a human solution.

I would guess that the disciples in the storm did the same. They turned the boat into the wind, tried to ride out the storm, bailed water out of the boat, tried every thing possible to save their lives. Only when all seemed to fail did they turn to Jesus. Jesus quiets the wind and calms the sea.

We can find great comfort in turning to Jesus. He can calm our fears, quiet the turmoil in our lives, and give us peace of mind. The same peace He gave the disciples in the upper room after His death. Our problems may still be there, but we can view them differently and be at peace with them. Turning to Jesus in prayer with an open mind can help us in the storms of life.

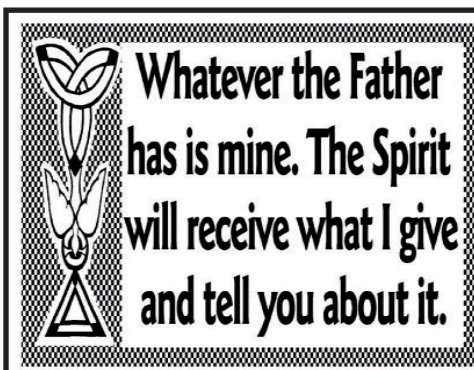
