


# ORDINARY TIME

Today we celebrate the 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, *Mark 4:35-41*, Jesus and His disciples decide to cross the Galilee lake to the other side. While on the lake, a violent squall came up with waves breaking over the boat. Jesus was in the stern asleep on a cushion. The disciples became afraid that they would parish and woke Jesus. Jesus woke up and rebuked the wind and the sea saying "quiet and be still". The wind ceased and there became a great calm. The disciples were filled with great awe.

In our lives there are many thing that cause us great fear. We have many worries that we have no control of. There are many sleepless nights about children, sickness, finances, the weather, my job, our friendships, the list goes on and on. We struggle with them, trying to find a solution. The same peace He gave the disciples in the upper room after His death. Our problems may still be there, but we can view them differently and be at peace with them. Turning to Jesus in prayer with an open mind can help us in the storms of life.

Eternal Rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let Perpetual Light shine them.


