

#### Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Mark 6:7-13, Jesus sends the twelve out two by two. He instructs them to take nothing with them for the journey but a walking stick, sandals, no food, no sack, no money in their belts, and no second tunic. Stay in one place in a town. If not welcome, leave and shake the dust from your feet as testimony to them.

Jesus sends us out as well, to preach repentance and, His message of the Kingdom of God. We are to imitate Jesus. We are empowered to do what He does, to live as He lived, to embrace a lifestyle of simplicity. Our many possessions can hold us back from going out to share the message. Just to take care of them takes a lot of our time. Dr. Dobson once said, "We don't own our possessions, our possessions own us". They can get in the way of sharing Jesus' message or living it.

We tend to rely on ourselves too often, to depend on things to convince someone of the love of God. Love of neighbor, respect for others, anti racism, divisiveness, and other issues cannot be fixed by more laws, more money or more things. You cannot force nor buy someone to love you, or to respect you; human nature does not work that way.

We need to learn to rely on Jesus and the Holy Spirit, and not on things, to change people's hearts. We need to give of our time in a loving manner and to meet everyone as if they were sent to us by Jesus, because they were. We are sent out as were the disciples, to heal, to console, to comfort, and to share the message of Jesus. We are His disciples today. We have His directives and blessing. He is sending us out. Let us not let Him down.


#### **Area Happenings**
