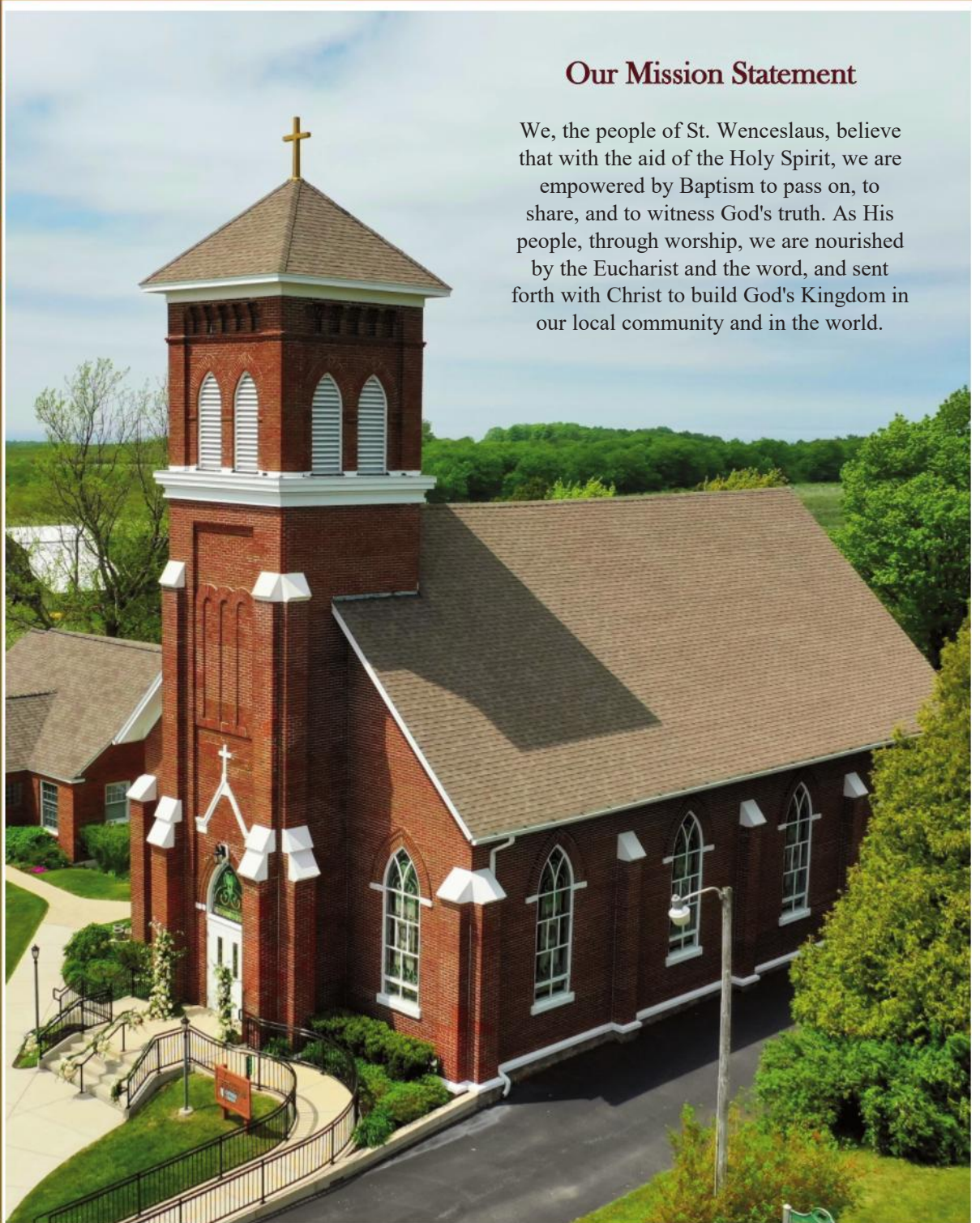

Today we celebrate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. In This week-end's Gospel, from Luke, we read the narrative about Mary's visitation to Elizabeth in the hill country. This is an example of Mary's willingness to reach out to others in need. She did not look at her life and say, "Woe is me. My life has been interrupted. My wedding plans, my family, my hopes in the future, etc. have all changed." In spite of all that happened to her, she continues to trust in the Lord. Because of her holiness, being full of grace, she was conceived with out original sin. The Church celebrates this occasion on December 8th.

Today we celebrate Mary's assumption in to heaven. The doctrine of the church states that Mary "having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory." 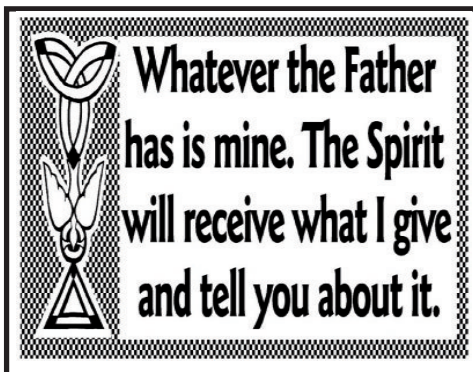
