

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time. In this weekend's Gospel, Mark 12: 38-44, Jesus watches the Scribes and the people putting money in the temple treasury. He criticized the scribes for taking places of honor while cheating the widows out of their property. He also compares the gift of the rich to that of the poor widow. Jesus does not discount the rich who gave some. He simply pointed out that the widow gave much more. She gave with her heart to the temple, to God. All that she had was a gift from God.

Jesus was impressed with her generosity. Giving is not necessarily all or nothing. It is sharing what God has given us. It is giving back to God what He first gave us. We are distributing the gifts He has given to world. We are not giving anything He has given to us first.

Be mindful of hypocrisy. Jesus is harsh toward people who give only for show. Somewhere it is said: "The right hand should not know what the left hand is giving." Sometimes a small gift can be priceless. God appreciates all that we give. Sometimes we give more than at other times. We are human beings, and God loves us in our humanity as human beings, and all that we give.

Giving is not only about money. There are many ways to give of ourselves. We can give of our talents, our time, our prayers, our conversation, our smile, acknowledging others. Don't wait for someone else to do it. Step up yourself. Remember all that we have is a gift from God. We need to share His gifts to us with others.


