

Today we celebrate the Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time. In this weekend's Gospel, Mark, 13: 24-32, Jesus talks of the end times when the Son of Man will come. There will be cosmic signs of things that will happen before His coming. Heaven and earth may pass away, but His words will never pass away. No one knows the day or hour, neither angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. But the coming of the Son of Man will indeed happen.

Throughout Scripture, we hear these words: be awake, be alert, be aware of the moment for we do not know what tomorrow will bring. We have only too look at life around us to know this is true. A pandemic comes without warning; a flash flood sweeps a car away' a building collapses in the middle of the night. 
Area Happenings


