Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time. In the Gospel of Luke, 1:1-4, 4:14-21, we hear Jesus reading from the scroll of Isaiah. "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord". After returning the scroll and sitting down, He said to them, "Today this scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing."

Jesus is telling the people of Nazareth, His home town, who He is, that the Spirit of the Lord was upon Him because He was anointed by the Lord at His baptism. He is also telling what He is going to do for them, to help them, and what His mission in life will be for all people. The time for the fulfillment of Scripture is to be fulfilled, that God's blessings are available today.

Jesus is willing and able to fulfill His promise to us here and now. He is here to free us from the captive of sin, bad habits, and any addictions. He will help us to see more clearly the many false statements that are out there and sort out the truth. He will free us from the fears we may have. He will help us live a good life, enjoying a peace that only He can give. He wants to rescue us from temptations that keep us from having a relationship with Him. Trust in Him. The time for fulfillment is now.


Thursdays: Faith Enrichment at St. Michael SB Fr. Baker Hall at 7 p.m.
