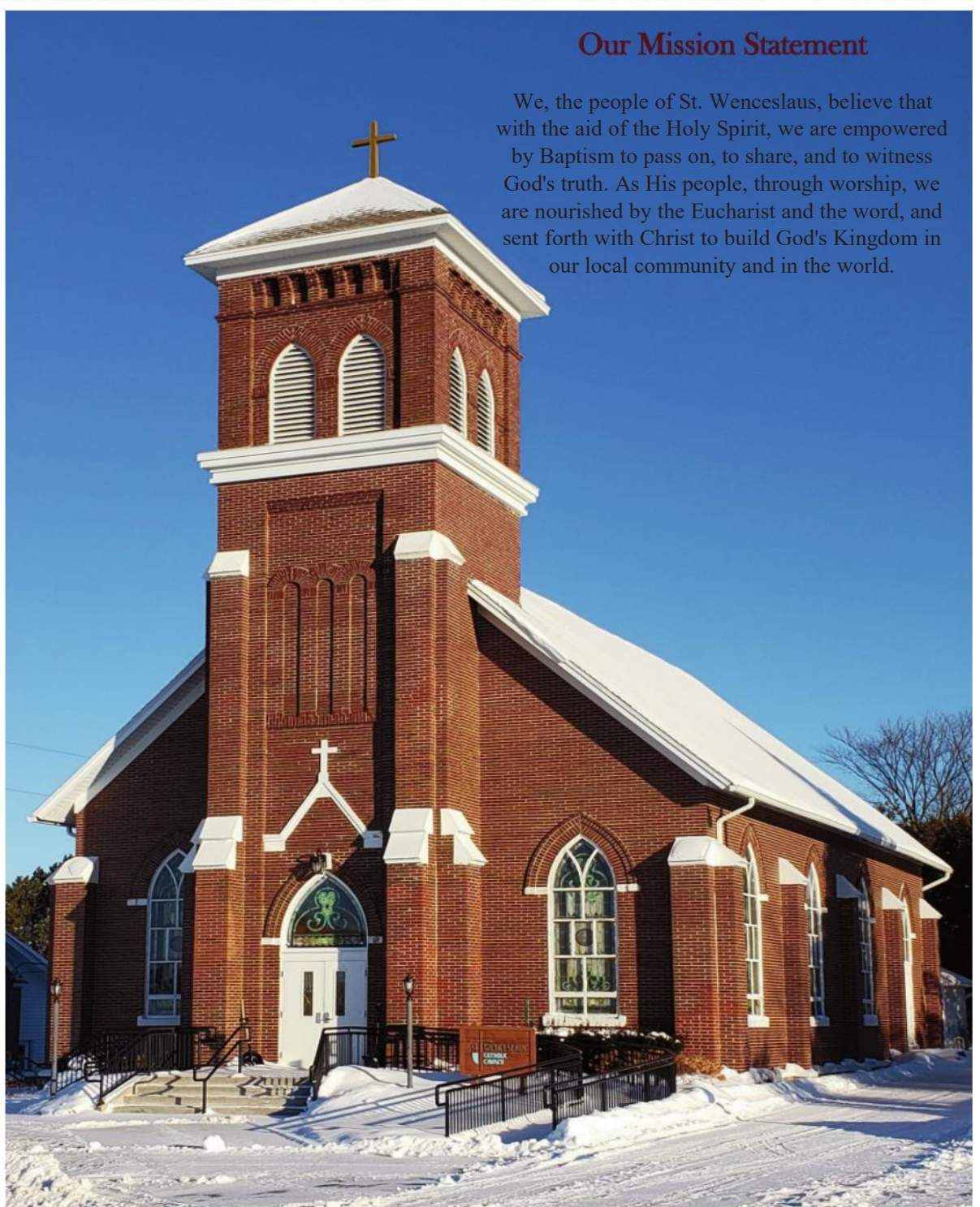

Today we celebrate the Sixth Sunday in ordinary time. The Gospel of Luke 6:17,20-26 we find Jesus standing on a stretch of level ground. He tells the disciples about the Beatitudes. He tells of the rewards they will get for enduring some of life's trials and difficulties with a spirit of justice and mercy. He also tells of the tragedies that will befall them in the next life if they only seek the happiness that the world offers.

Jesus is giving us a hint of what is in store for us in the next life as well. Any message he gives to His disciples He is also giving to us. He tells us to rejoice and leap for joy when they persecute us for we know we have been found worthy to be called one of His followers.

There is an old saying that goes like this: "If you were arrested for being a Christian, would they find enough evidences to convict you?" This a question we all need to look at and answer. Are we any different than the atheist? If in a line up, would they be able to pick you out? Do your friends know you are? Do you share your faith? When asked to pray for someone, do you pray with them? Would anyone come to your defense or accuse you of being a Christian? Is your behavior consistent, or do you treat some better than others? Do you talk about your faith openly? Do you share your faith? Do you share your story? Do you tell others how God has worked in your life?

Is there enough evidence to convict you? Would you rejoice in the outcome?
