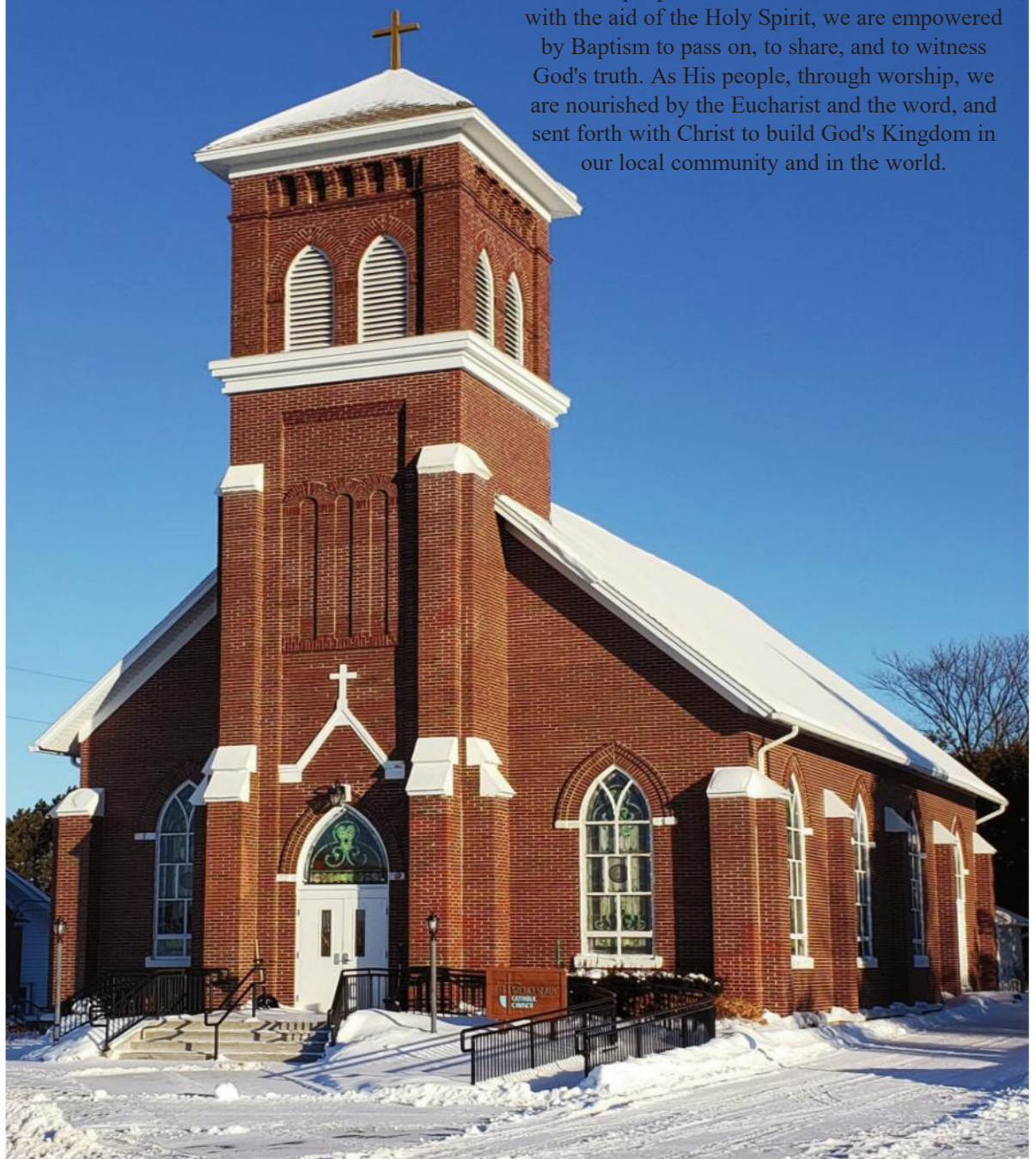

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Seventh Sunday in ordinary time. In the Gospel of Luke 6:27-38, we find Jesus talking to His disciples. He tells them to love their enemies. Do good to those who hate you. Turn the other cheek. Lend without expecting a return. If one needs your cloak, give him your shirt, do to others as you would have them do to you. Stop judging and you will not be judged. Stop condemning and you will not be condemned. Forgive and you will be forgiven. Give and it will be given to you. A very different message that the people were not used to hearing nor practiced.

This message is counter cultural today as well, but still is the same message for us today. Today's Gospel tells us what we are to do in life and why. It isn't vast theological knowledge, or personal charm, or professional success. Nor is it ecstasies in prayer or extreme penances. If we are truly His children, His followers, we will be quick to forgive, to make excuses for others, to avoid judging and condemning them. We will be generous in our giving. We will think well of others, speak well of them, and treat them like the children of God that they truly are. Greeting everyone as if they are an image of God. If we look for good in people, we will find it.

God is kind and merciful, even to the ungrateful and the wicked. If we are his followers, we will be too. If we are true Christians, treating all others as we would like them to treat us, as God has treated us, we will be truly happy. The message of Jesus gives hope to the world. Let's all do our part to make this a better world and gain eternal life in heaven.

The Whole People of God – ordained, religious, and lay alike – are commissioned to carry out the mission of Jesus Christ in the world. In the Holy Spirit, living in all the faithful, each member of the Church is given a part in drawing the world into communion with Christ. This participation of the baptized in the Church's sacred mission, each according to their proper role, is called synodality. Pope Francis has asked that, prior to the 2023 meeting of the Synod of Bishops in Rome, the People of God have an opportunity to contribute their prayerful reflection on how well the Church exercises synodality at various levels. In the months to come, the Diocese of Gaylord will respond to this invitation in "synodal consultations" to be organized in parishes and clusters throughout the diocese. There will be tables of small groups with facilitators in our Parish. All are invited to come and share their thoughts.

The Parish offers its condolences to the family of Jean Sedlacek who passed away this past week. Surviving Jean is her daughter, Pam, and sons, Ron and Randy. In your kindness, please pray for the repose of her soul and comfort for her family and friends.
