

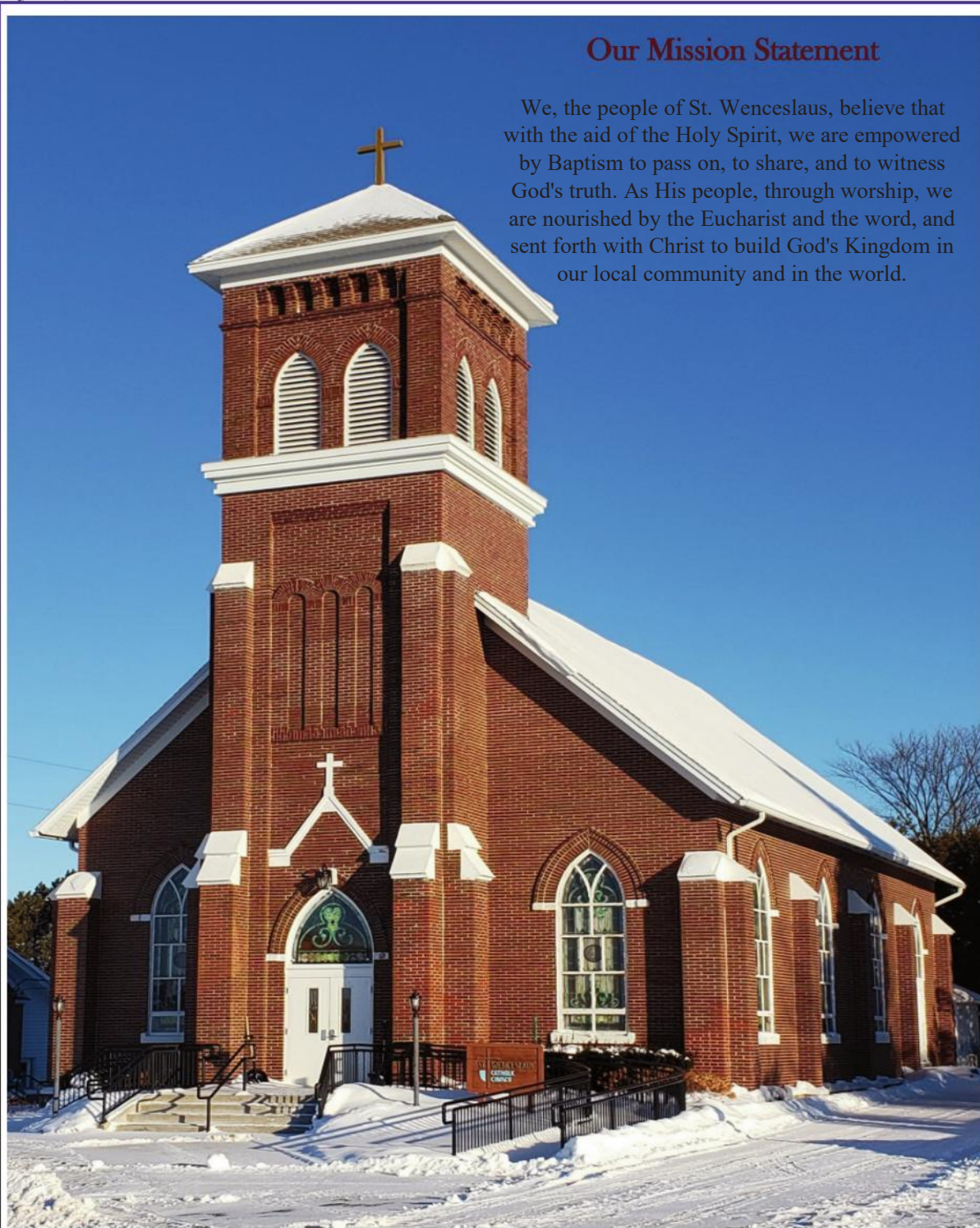

We would not ask a blind person to lead us across the street. We look out for our physical welfare. We are careful when dealing with our material property. Should we not be just as careful with our spiritual life? Pick who you will follow very carefully. In matters of faith and morals we should seek the advice of a faithful and moral person, discuss with a church leader, check the Catholic Catechism, read scripture, and pray on it. If you check all the sources, you will not be led astray. Do not let yourself be led by the blind or those who do not know Jesus. We are all making decisions as we cross the street of life. Choose wisely.

**This coming Wednesday** is Ash Wednesday. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence meaning that no meat is allowed. A fast day means that one full meal and two lesser meals are allowed. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics who have reached the age of fourteen. Fasting is for those who have reached the age of eighteen until the beginning of their sixtieth year.

**Little Black Books-6-Minute-Meditations on the Sunday Gospels of Lent** are available in the vestibule. There are also copies of The Word Among Us for Lenten reflection.

**There will be Stations of the Cross starting next Saturday and Sunday,** after Lenten Masses. Readers of the day and altar servers are asked to stay and lead the Stations.
