Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate Palm Sunday. Today we have two Gospels. One is Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem, a great parade, recognizing Jesus as the Messiah. The other is the Passion of our Lord a few days later. In this Gospel, we hear of the last days of His life. His agony over what He was about to undergo, of the loneliness that He would experience when all would abandon Him, of no one coming to His defense. Of the physical abuse he would endure, of His final moments on the cross, His forgiving of His persecutors, all that Jesus went through to show how much he loved us, what He would do for our salvation, and what He was willing to endure to mend our relationship with God our Father. We call this the Passion of Jesus.

The Passion is God saying to us: "No matter what you do, I will keep on loving You. I will never let you down." If we reject Him, scourge Him, crown Him with thorns, betray Him, even if we crucify Him, He continues to love us: "Father, forgive them, they know not what they do." God's love and faithfulness doesn't depend on us being perfect, and it doesn't depend on His whims. He will never take it back. We can trust Him completely.

That's the message of the Passion. And it's the message that each of us, wounded and sinful as we are, most need to hear. Jesus is waiting for us to come to Him, to mend our relationship with God our Father so we can spend all eternity with Him.
