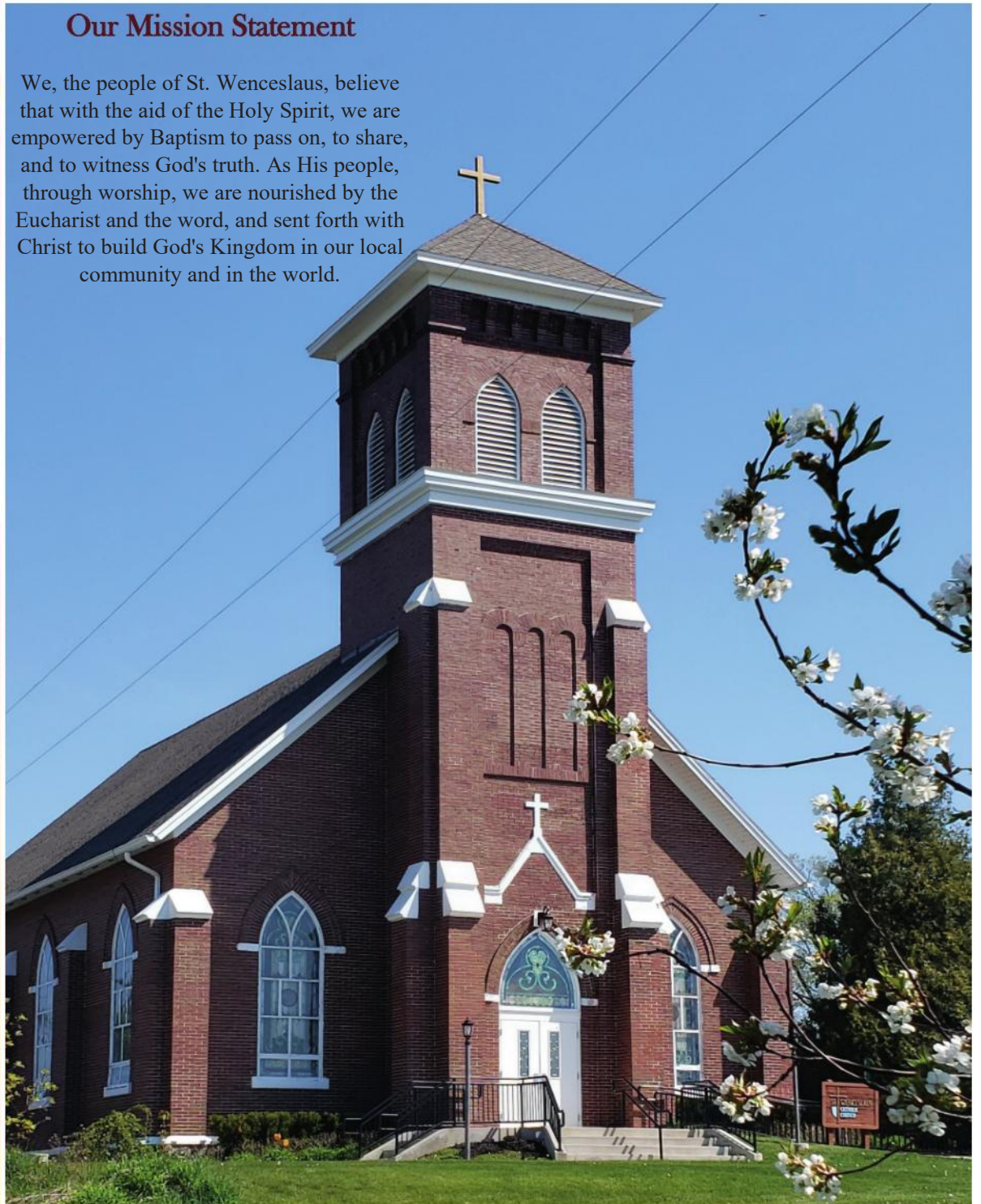




# 5th Sunday *of Easter*
