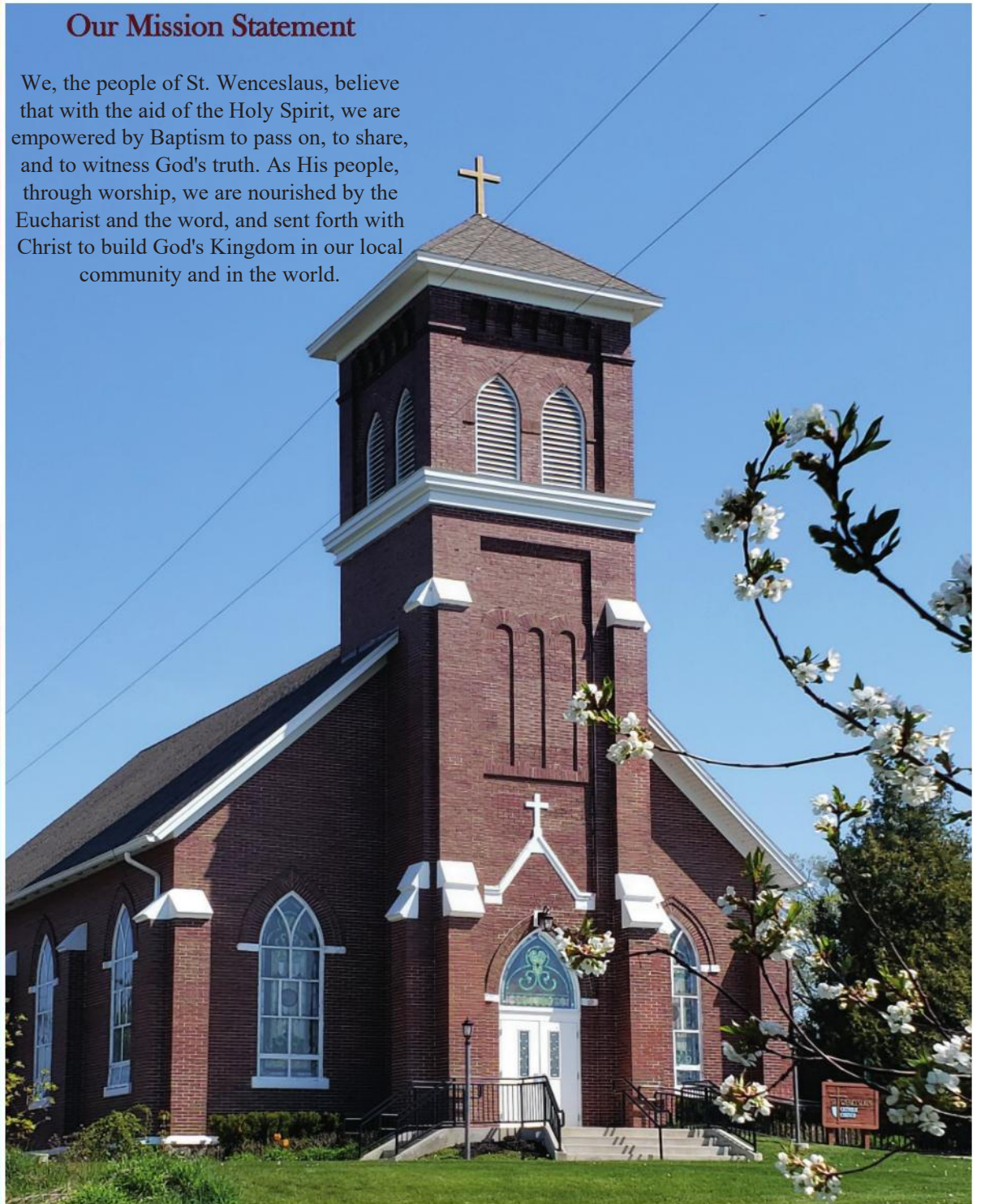

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today is the Sixth Sunday of Easter. In today's Gospel, John 14:23-29, Jesus is preparing His disciples for the time when he will not be with them. He is going away but will return to them. Jesus tells His disciples: "The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you. My peace I give you, do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid".

The message Jesus gave to His disciples is for us as well. The Holy Spirit, the Advocate, is here, today, to assist us in our daily lives. The Advocate is some times called the comforter, counselor, or helper. He will teach in Jesus' absence but the content of the teaching will be Jesus' own. He will remind us of all Jesus taught.

At baptism and confirmation we receive the Holy Spirit. It is up to us to acknowledge and connect with the Holy Spirit. We do this through prayer. Prayer consisting of being open and listening. Once we learn how to listen, He will be able to direct us in all situations, sometimes even putting words in to our mouths that we do not know where they came from.

Jesus also offer His peace to His disciples. A peace the world can not give. These are troubling times. Accept the peace He gives us. Life will be good. Give the Holy Spirit a chance and you will experience a peace that can only come from Him. Jesus promised it. He does not go back on His word. Talk to Him, Pray.
