Today we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord. In today's Readings, we read of Jesus' last instructions to His disciples. They will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon them, and they will be His witness in Jerusalem, and throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth. The disciples watched as Jesus ascended into a cloud. As they were watching, there appeared two men dressed in white garments standing by them. They said, "Men of Galilee, why are you standing here looking at the sky? Jesus will return in the same way you have seen Him going onto heaven."

Live in a manner worthy of the calling by Christ. Be humble, gentle, patient, and love one another. Our actions speak louder than words. Now is the time. Don't just stand there looking up. Live the message.
