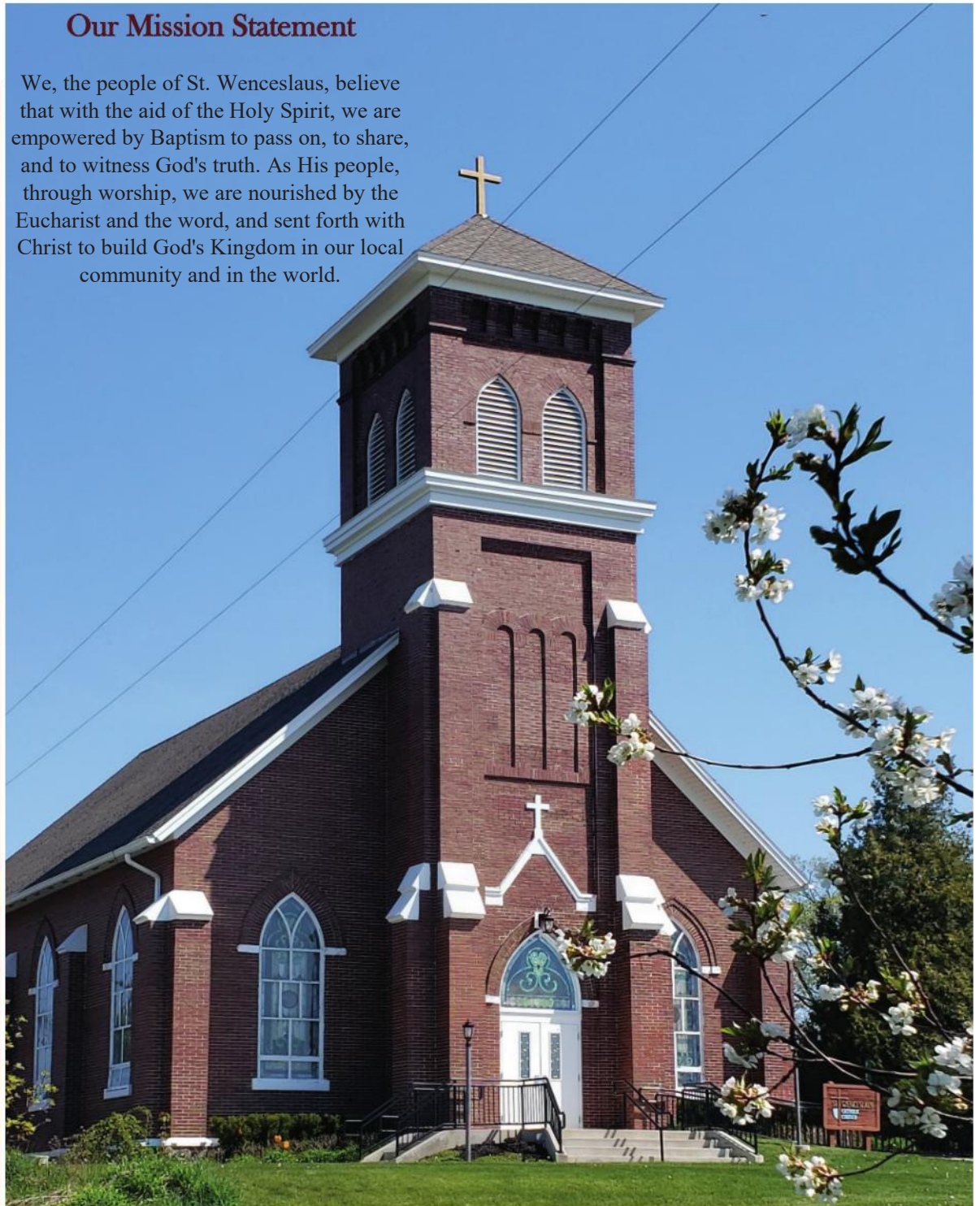




PENTECOST

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate Pentecost Sunday. This is the day the Holy Spirit descended on the apostles. The apostles had seen the Ascension just ten days before. They went to the upper room, and prayed for ten days. They were afraid for fear of the Jews. The Holy Spirit descended on them in a physical way, in the form of tongues of fire. They began to speak in different tongues as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim. Their lives were changed forever.

There were many nationalities present in the area where the Apostles were praying. Each individual received the Spirit. Each individual received the gift of tongues, to speak to another in their native language. They left the upper room and went out into the world. They were no longer afraid to share the message of Jesus. They did something.

We have all received the Holy Spirit at Baptism and Confirmation, the same Spirit the Apostles received. Each of us receives it in different ways. Each of us is asked to go out into the world and share the message of Jesus' death and resurrection. We are to tell of His saving power. To share how He has worked in our lives. To rely on the Holy Spirit for guidance, both in word and action.

Remember the apostles gathered to gather, as a group, as a church, and prayed for ten days. It did not just happen. They put forth effort together. So must we. Pray together, and be open to the Holy Spirit to work in our lives. This may mean, setting aside our agenda, and listening to Him. Pray and listen. He will answer.
