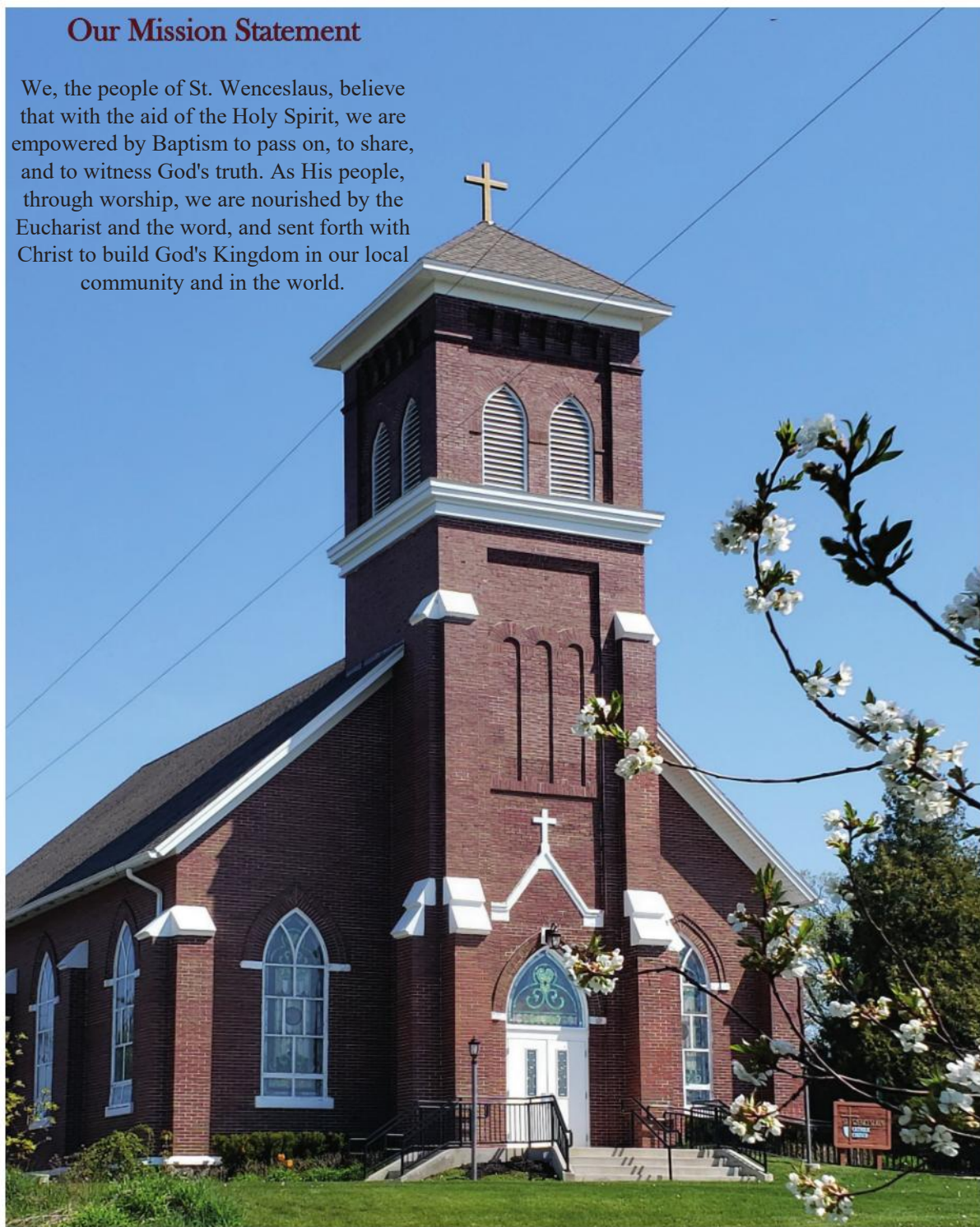

This message comes to you from California. The weather is great. Sun every day. Cool at night and warm during the day. The altitude is 2,657. This is about 2,000 feet more than we are in Leelanau County. Any walking and we get out of breath very easy. I am not in as good of shape as I thought. We are enjoying the time here.

This Sunday's Gospel, John 16:12-15, Jesus tells His disciples that He has much more to tell them, but they cannot handle it now. Later the Spirit of Truth will come to them. He will take what is Jesus' and declare it to you.

In our life we may think if only we knew what would happen next, we could avoid many misfortunes. Life would be better for us, for all. If only we knew now, we would decide differently. Life is a series of lessons, steps of learning. We cannot run until we learn to walk. We cannot sing until we learn to talk. We cannot know unless there is someone to teach us. The Holy Spirit can teach us if we are open to Him.

There is much we do not know or understand. This was true of the apostles as well. Jesus told them the Spirit would tell them what they would say when the time came. We are on a need to know basis. This requires a great amount of trust in God and the Spirit. He came through for the apostles, He will come through for us. He did in the past, He will in the future. Continue to trust in Jesus, the Holy Spirit, and He'll tell you all you need to know. Be patient, pray, and trust in the Lord.
