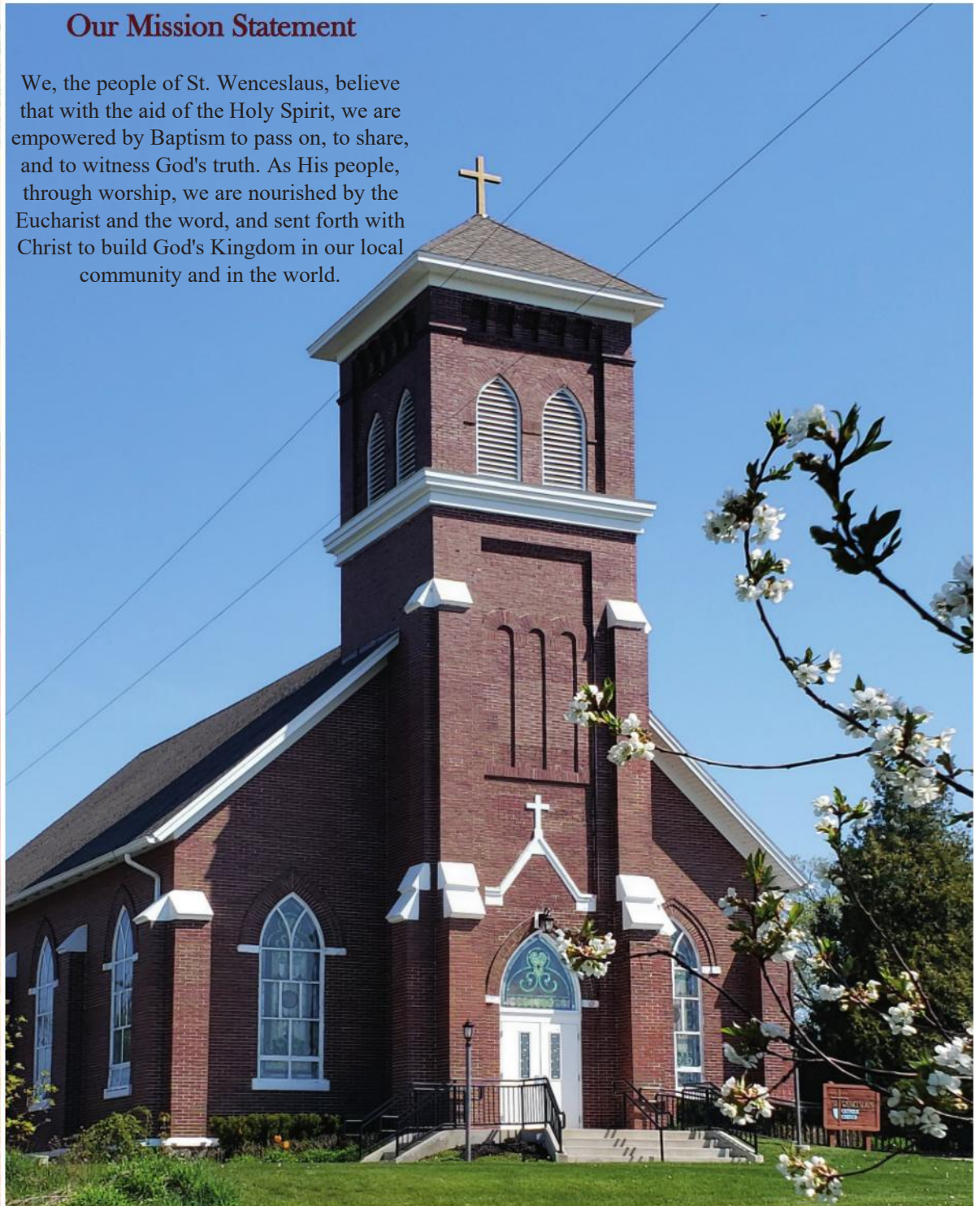

### Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. In today's Gospel, Luke 9:11b-17, Jesus feeds five thousand men with five loaves and two fish. This is a very familiar reading which we have all heard and read many times. It is easy to overlook the magnitude of what took place. Not only was it five thousand men but additional women and children. There were more than five thousand people. Just imagine a football stadium full of people, and feeding them all with just five loaves and two fish. It just cannot happen, but with Jesus anything can happen.

Jesus blessed the food, and gave it to the disciples. With Jesus, blessing all things are possible. The disciples came to Jesus with what they thought was a big problem. They wish to brush it aside. Let the people take care of it themselves. Jesus wants us to get involved. He wants to work with us. We need to cooperate with Him.

Jesus recognized the need of the people, and asked His disciples to give some food themselves. He wanted them to help Him. He wants us to help Him. We are his hands and feet today. We are to take what we have and share it with others. We are to share our faith as well. Jesus gave more than enough.

At Mass, the priest blesses the bread and wine in place of Jesus. Jesus blesses the bread and wine and it becomes His body and blood. He gives us Himself, He gives us more than enough. He walks with us just as He walked with the disciples.

We see Jesus in a real way in the bread and the wine at Mass. How we respond to Him makes a difference in our life. We can walk with Him or try and solve our problems ourselves. Trust in Him, you will not be disappointed. He will care for you.

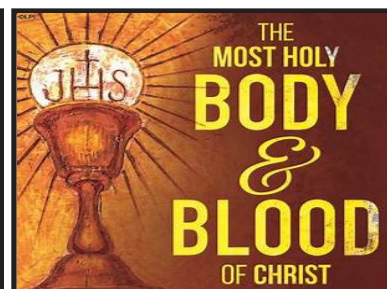
