Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Luke 9:51-62, Jesus is on His way to Jerusalem. He sends messengers ahead of Himself. They were not welcome in a Samaritan village because they were only passing through on their way to Jerusalem. They asked Jesus if they should call down fire from heaven to consume them.

How quickly we react like the disciples, and judge people who do not think like we do. Not only do we judge them, but we condemn them as well. How often do we hear people label others as right or left, holy or not, prejudge, or bias, they are Catholic, racists, white supremacist, etc. Jesus rebukes us for this type of thought. He journeyed to another village, to a different group of people. Do not let yourself be distracted by their way of thought. If you do, you may be swallowed up in their mission of destruction.

Follow Christ, do not look back as to what was there. Keep focused on Jesus. As He said, "No one who sets a hand to the plow and looks what was left behind is fit for the kingdom of God". When we look back we lose sight of what is in front of us. When we take our eyes off the road, our car may wonder. So it is with Christ. Stay focused, look ahead, do not be distracted by others, and pray. Journey with Jesus.
