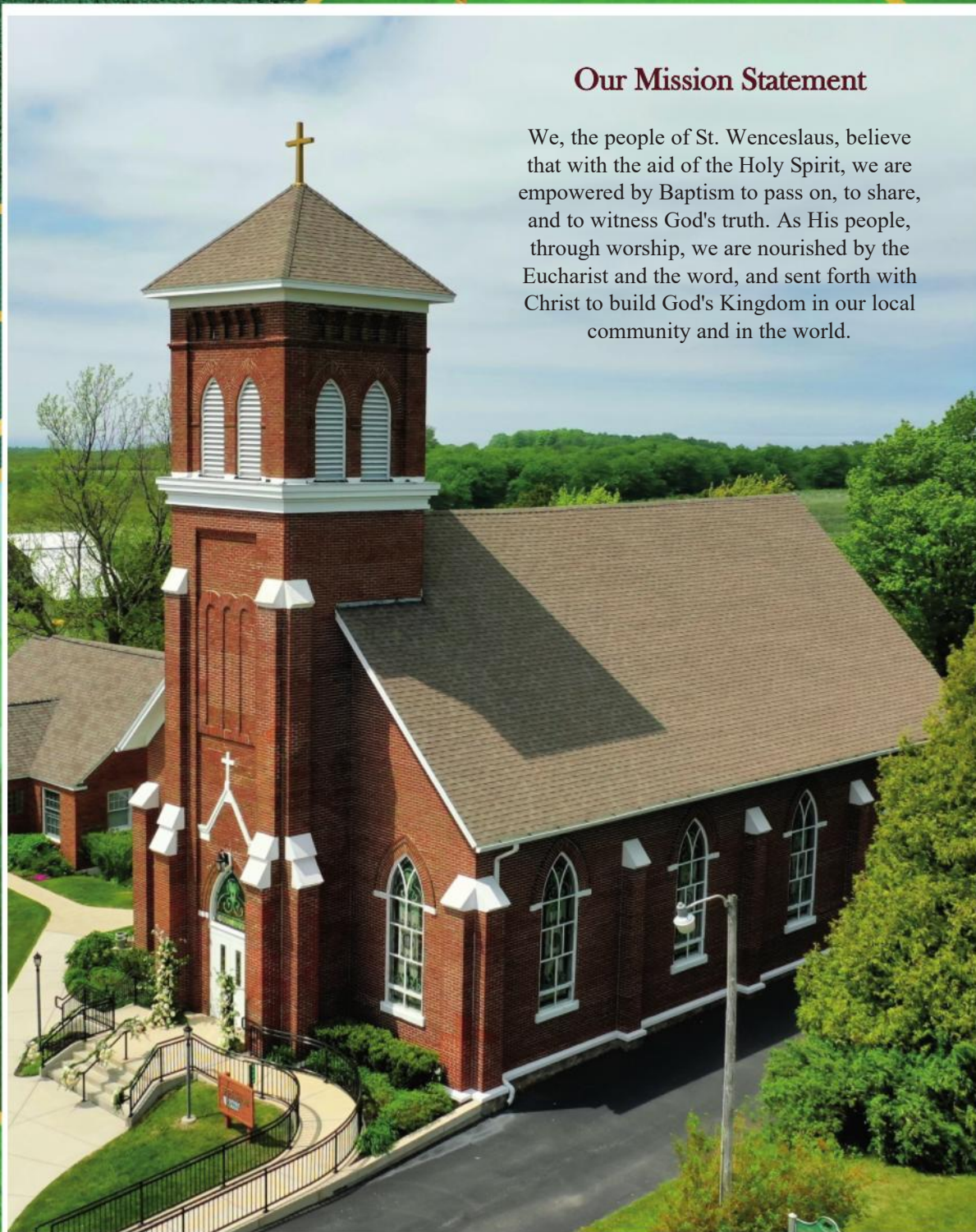

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Luke 10:25-37, Jesus is asked, "What must I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus' response is to keep the commandments. Then He tells the parable of the good Samaritan. Who is my neighbor? The priest, the Levite, both had reasons why they could not help. They even went out of their way and walked on the opposite side of the street. Their belief prevented them from touching this person for they would become unclean. They would then have to go through a process of cleaning. This was a deliberate choice. The Samaritan treated him with compassion and cared for him without any concern for himself. He was neighbor to him.

Jesus is asking us, "Who is our neighbor"? In this time of divisiveness and hatred, are there people we would walk on the opposite side of the street in order to avoid them? Choosing to not speak to them, not acknowledging their presence, refusing to help them or accept their help, holding a grudge. Who do we refuse to work with? Who are we sarcastic with? Who do we not have time for?

There are many ways to ignore someone. We do not know how someone is hurting or the cross they are carrying. We may never know if we walk on the opposite side of the street. As scripture states: "Treat them with mercy." Treat them all like neighbors. Go and do as the Samaritan did.
