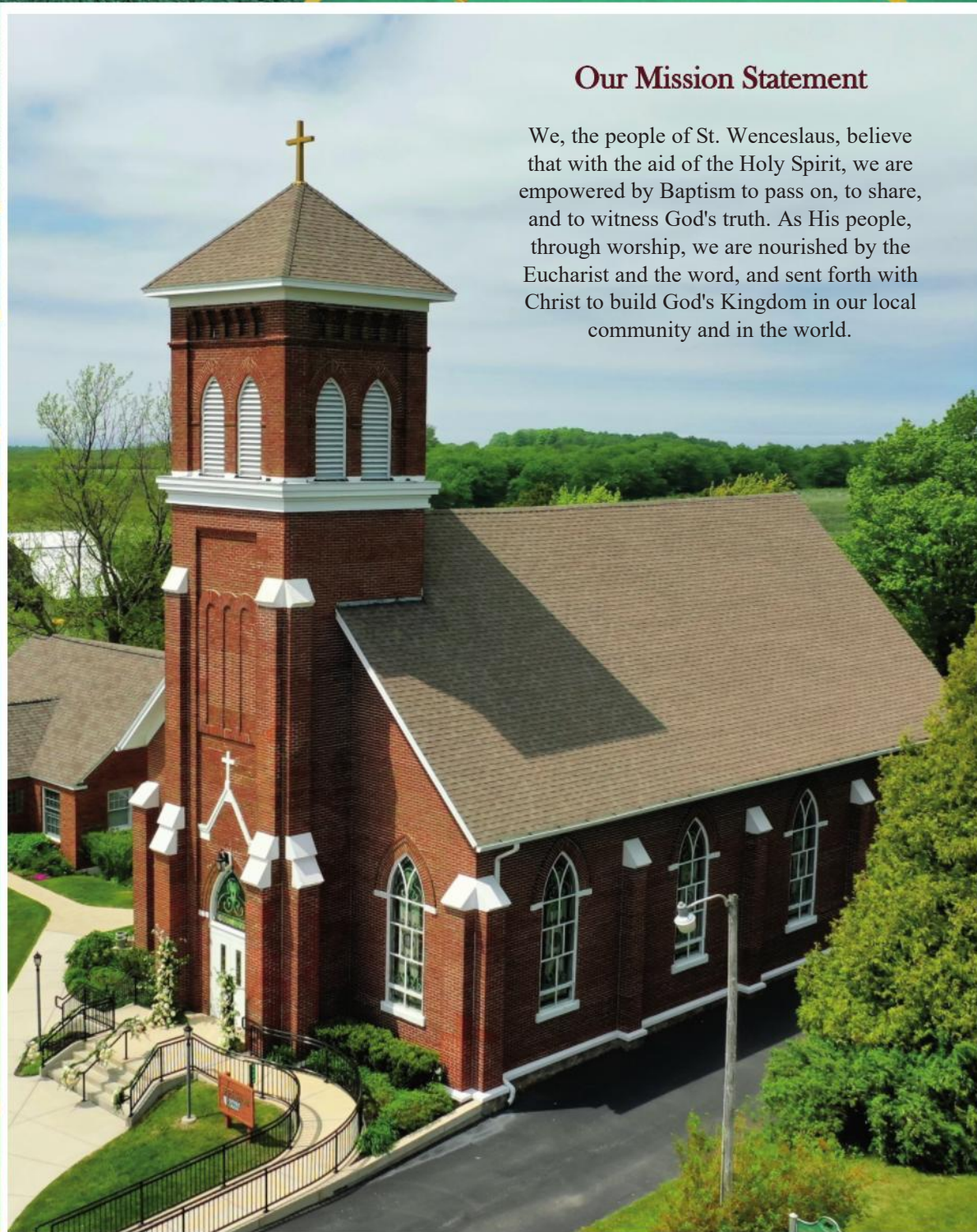

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Luke 10:38-42, Jesus enters a village where two women, Martha and her sister, Mary, lived. Martha, working to serve Jesus was very busy, while Mary sat at His feet listening to Him speak. Martha went to Jesus and asked Him to instruct Mary to help her. Jesus told Martha: "You are anxious and worried about many things. Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her."

We are like Martha in many ways, anxious and worried about many things. We go about our way thinking we know what is best. We make choices with little or no information. We make judgments without knowing the facts. We insist our opinion is the only one that has merit based on the common thought of the day.

Jesus reminds us that it is not only the task, the ministry, that is important, but the relationship with God is more important. Not to just be good, do good, but we must have a personal relationship with God. We must be willing to sit down with Him and listen. This we call prayer. Take time with Jesus so He can say of us: "You have chosen the better part and it will not be taken from you."
