

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Luke 11:1-13, one of Jesus' disciples ask Him to teach them to pray. Jesus teaches them the Lord's prayer, The Our Father. He goes on to tell them to ask the Father for their needs. To be persistent, and the Father will answer, giving the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him.

We have all said the Lord's Prayer hundreds of times. We learned it at an early age, and so it is repeated from memory. But sometimes we are saying words, not conscious of what we are saying. God hears but He would like our attention as well. When we speak to each other, we are attentive to each other so as to communicate. So it is in our prayer with God. We are to place ourselves in the presences of God, and give him our undivided attention. At least try.

In the beginning of the Gospel it states that Jesus was praying in a certain place. Jesus was often praying. He went off by Himself to pray, when He was 12 in the temple, before miracles, in difficult times, storms, in the Mount of Olives, and others. If He, who is the son of God, found it necessary to pray often, should we not do so as well?

He starts with the words, "Our Father". He is asking us to recognize God as our Father, someone who is close to us, who has a personal interest in us, who cares for us, and wishes the best for us. We say "Our", meaning He is not just my Father, but yours as well. And if He is our father, then we are brothers and sisters in Christ as well. It is a powerful prayer. Focus on the words, and it will come alive with meaning.
