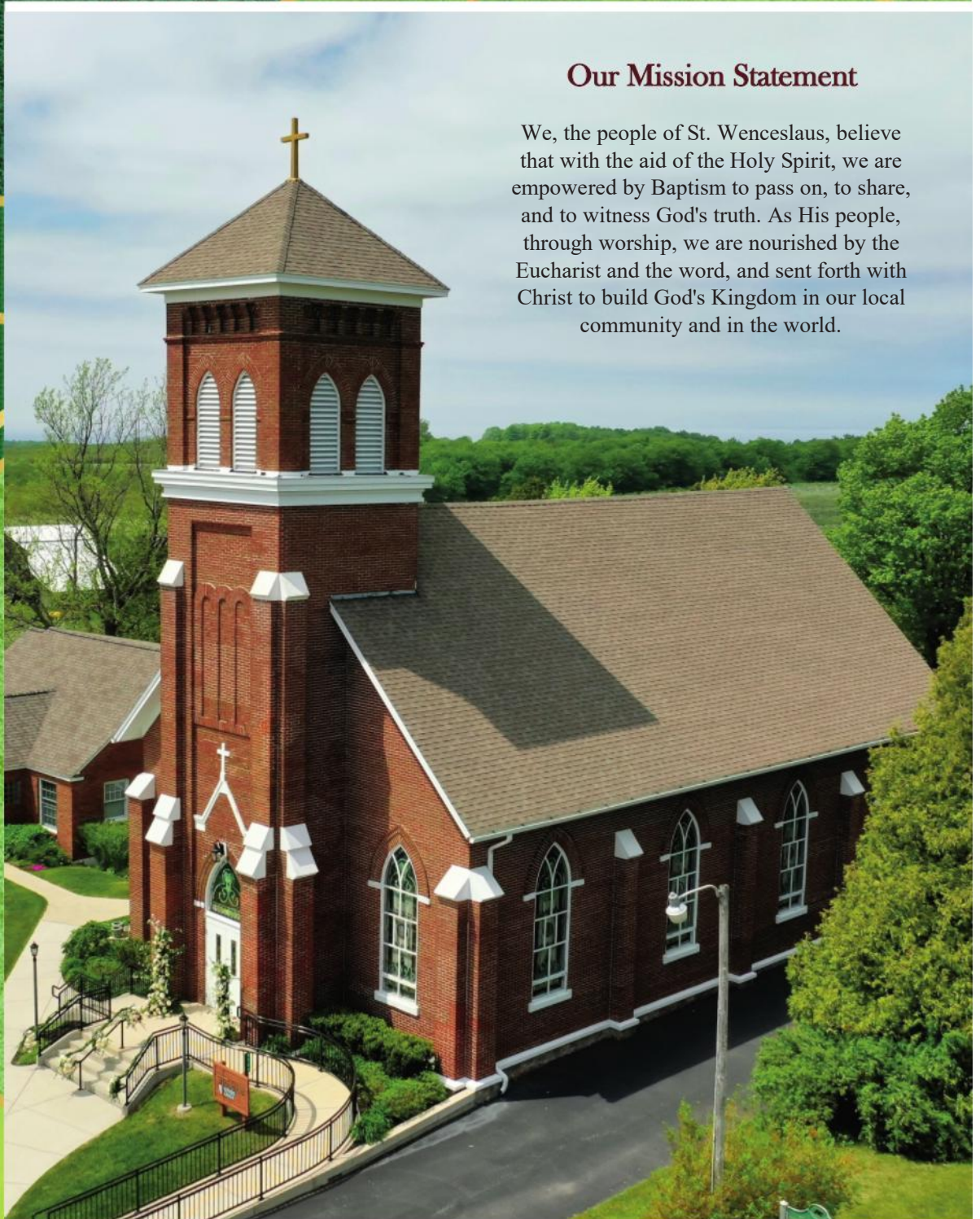

Today we celebrate The Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time.
