Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Luke 15:1-32, Jesus tells the Pharisees and the Scribes three parables. A man loosing one of a hundred sheep, a woman loosing a coin, and the prodigal son, and the rejoicing when the sheep was found, the rejoicing when the coin is found, and the rejoicing when the son returns home. The prodigal son is well known. It has a special message for all of us.

One of the insights we often overlook has to do with the danger we face as so-called "practicing Catholics". The danger of living our faith only on the surface, of living in the father's house without really getting to know the father.

The younger son didn't know how much his father loved him. How he wanted to give him prosperity and joy. The son insulted his father by demanding his share of the inheritance before his father passed away. He was telling his father that he was of more use to him dead than alive.

The older son was no better. On the surface he seemed to do every thing right. But he had no idea about how much his father loved him, so he resented the celebration at his brother's return. The father came out to him but he refused to enter into his father's house. The father went out to both his sons.

We can easily do the same. We can spend our whole lives living as practicing Catholics. We can go through all the right motions, looking great on the outside. But not opening our hearts to God, not getting to know him on a personal, intimate level. We could miss a lot, we could miss out on the joyful celebration of the Father's love.

We can miss eternal life with God the Father.


