

### Dear fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Luke 19:1-10, Jesus came to a town called Jericho. As he was passing through, a man called Zacchaeus, a chief tax collector, wanted to see Him. He was short in stature so he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore tree. Jesus when passing by calls out to Zacchaeus: "Come down, I want to stay at your house." Zacchaeus came down with great joy and told Jesus of what he would do, give half his possessions to the poor, if he has extorted anything, he would repay four times over. Jesus responds: "Today salvation has come to this house."

The crowds grumbled that Jesus had gone to a house of a sinner. They did not recognize that Jesus had come for them. Zacchaeus recognized Jesus, and was welcomed into a new life. The crowd remained as they were.

When we see a change in someone's life to follow Jesus more closely, when they welcome Jesus in to their home, into their life, do we rejoice or do we say it is not right, not fair? Do we allow people to change? Do we notice them enough to recognize their effort to change and draw closer to Jesus? Are we like Zacchaeus or the crowd?


