

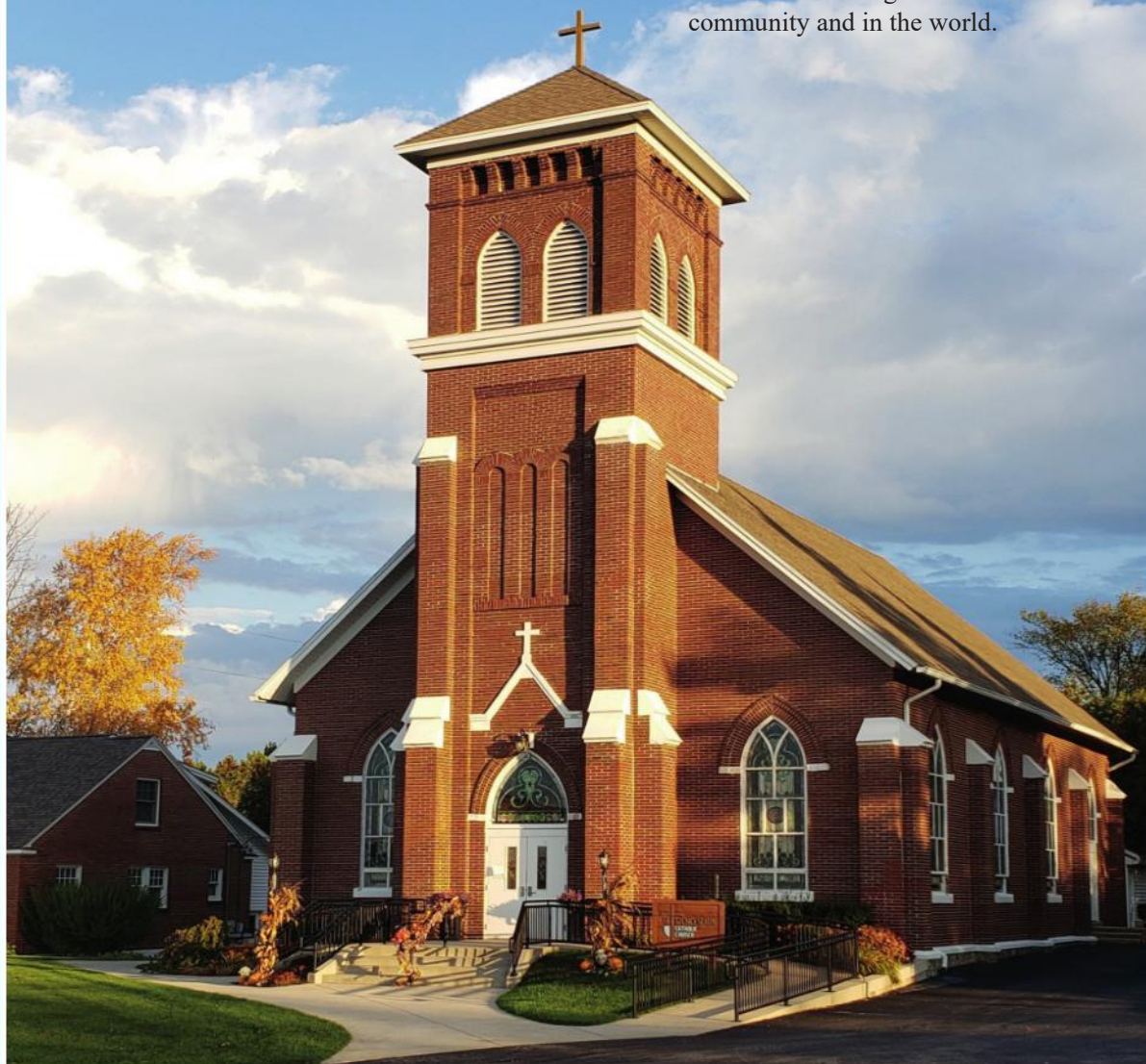


# VOCATION AWARENESS

Today we celebrate The Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Luke 20:27-38, some Sadducees question Jesus about the resurrection. They each married the woman, but they all died childless. The wife dies as well. Now at the resurrection, whose wife will she be?

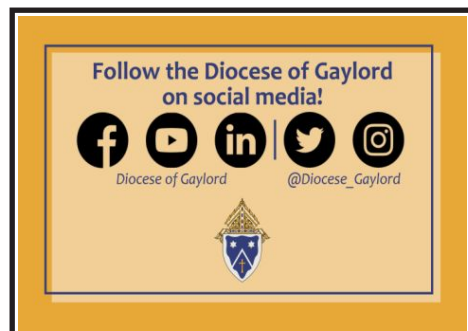
