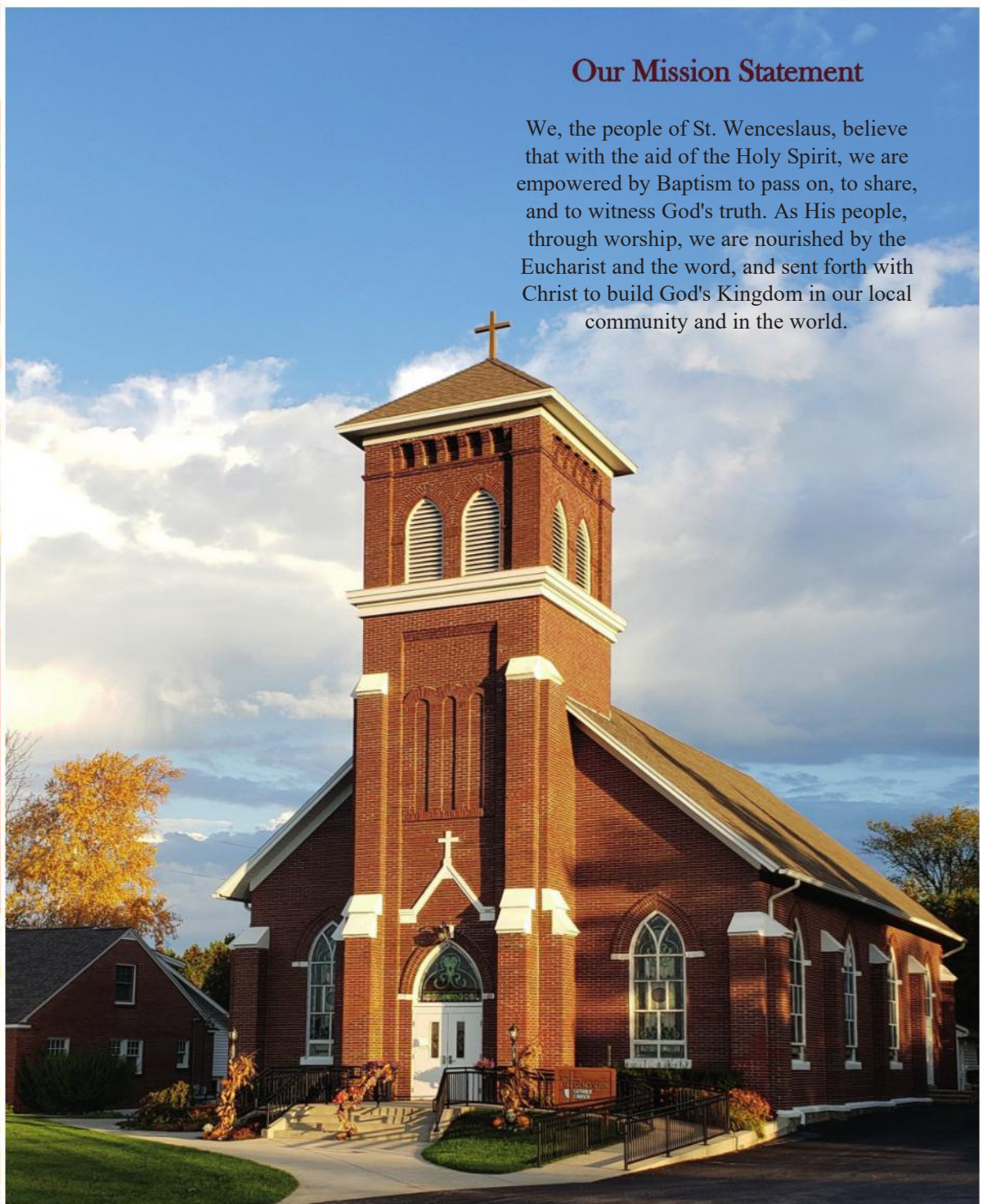

Dear fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. In today's Gospel, Luke 23:35-43, Jesus is on mount Calvary, being mocked by the soldiers, the crowds, and one of the thieves who was crucified with Him. The sign above His head read: "This is the King of the Jews." What was said in jest, was actually the truth.
