

Dear fellow Parishioners.

Today we celebrate the First Sunday of Advent. In today's Gospel, Matthew 24:37-44, Jesus is talking to his disciples about the Second coming of the Son of Man. People will be living their normal lives, eating, drinking, and giving in marriage. Two people will be working in the field; one will be taken and one will be left behind. Therefore, stay awake! For you do not know on which day your Lord will come.

Jesus' message is very simple: He is coming back, we do not know when, and we better be ready. He is really coming back. The second coming will be just as real, just as literal, as the first. We do not know the details of how He will return. Divine revelation comes to us on a "need to know" basis. He tells us not everyone will be taken to heaven. That's scary. We don't want to believe it. But we better because He said it. If we can't trust Him, we can't trust anyone about anything.

We do not know when this will happen. It may happen tonight. It may be a thousand years. What we can be sure of is, that we cannot be sure of when he will come. He does not tell us the time so that we will be ready all the time. Jesus will come for the whole world at the end of time. But he will also come to each one of us when we die. We do not know when we will die, so we must be ready to die at any time. Beginning now!

Abuse of Minors and Vulnerable Adults by Priests, Deacons, and Others

To report allegations of sexual abuse of minors or vulnerable adults within the Diocese of Gaylord by priests, deacons or other employees or volunteers, regardless of when it occurred, individuals should: Contact local law enforcement and the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (855-444-3911). The Michigan Attorney General's Office has also set up a special phone line for people to share information that may be of help in their ongoing investigation of sexual misconduct by Catholic clergy. That number is 844-324-3374. You may also contact the Diocesan Victim Assistance Coordinator, Larry LaCross, at 989-705-9010.

In the State of Michigan many professionals, including clergy, teachers, doctors, counselors and named others are mandated reporters. This means such individuals are REQUIRED to make an oral or online report IMMEDIATELY to the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services if they suspect a child is being neglected or abused in any way. Individuals may call the state report line at the number above, which is answered 24 hours a day, or submit a report online at www.michigan.gov/mdhhs/adult-child-serv/abuse-neglect/childrens/report-process.


