

#### Dear fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Second Sunday of Advent. In today's Gospel, Matthew 3:1-12, Matthew is talking about John the Baptist and his message, Repent and do good works. Every tree that does not bear good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire. He tells of one greater than he who is coming, one whom he is not worthy to carry his sandals.

We can repent only with God's help. With His help we can reform our lives and do more good deeds and fewer bad ones. If repentance makes absolutely no difference to our behavior, it is not real but fake. Repentance is proved by deeds, not by words or feelings.

Repentance is a choice, a free choice, to avoid oneself from evil; it is accepting God who is goodness. It is turning around 180 degrees, from facing darkness to facing the sun light. It is accepting God into our lives after ignoring Him for many years.

The sacrament of confession is a place where we can formally repent, a place where we can admit our sins, make a commitment to change and do good deeds. It is a place where God forgives and welcomes us back into His friendship, gives us a fresh start, again and again.

We know we will sin again; that's why the sacrament of reconciliation is not a one time sacrament like Baptism. Please take advantage of the times confession is offered in the area.
