### Dear fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Second Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, John 1:29-34, we are told the narrative of John the Baptist seeing Jesus coming towards him and states: "Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world." He further stated that he saw the Spirit come down like a dove from heaven and remain upon Him, I did not know Him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water told me, He is the one who will baptize with the Holy Spirit, and that He is the Son of God.

John is refuting the claim that Jesus was just another prophet. John's baptism was one of repentance, it did not take away sin. He is telling them to believe in the one who comes after him. When Jesus was baptized in the water of the Jordan, the water did not do anything for Him. But He did something to the water, He gave it the power to cleanse our sins in baptism. Jesus gives us Himself: He gives us His Spirit in Baptism and His Body in the Eucharist.

John states that he did not know Him, but the Holy Spirit told him. Doubting Thomas did not believe until he saw Him and stated, "My Lord and my God." These are the words we should all say when we receive communion. It is not up to us to whether He is the Lord and God. But it is up to us whether He is my Lord and my God.


