### Dear fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord. In today's Gospel, Matthew 28:16-20, is setting the stage for Jesus' Ascension into heaven. Jesus is meeting with the eleven disciples giving some of their last instructions. He tells them that "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold I am with you always, until the end of the age."

Jesus is telling the disciples, telling us, that they, us, are to reach out to all the nations. His message is not just for us, not for ourselves, but to be shared, to boldly go to others, to live the message, to bring Jesus to all nations. We are to continue this mission in spreading Christianity.

Jesus also gave us the formula for baptizing people in to the faith. Many other Christian Faiths use this same formula. The Catholic Faith accepts the baptism of other Christian Faiths as valid if they use this formula. If they wish to join the Catholic Faith, they must make a commitment to follow the Church's teaching and her way of worship.

Jesus' closing remarks are that He will never leave us. He will always be with us. We are never alone. We always have some one to turn to, to console us, to comfort us, to talk to, to share our joys and sorrows. He is ever present to us. We just need to be open to Him. He is always with us, are we with Him?




