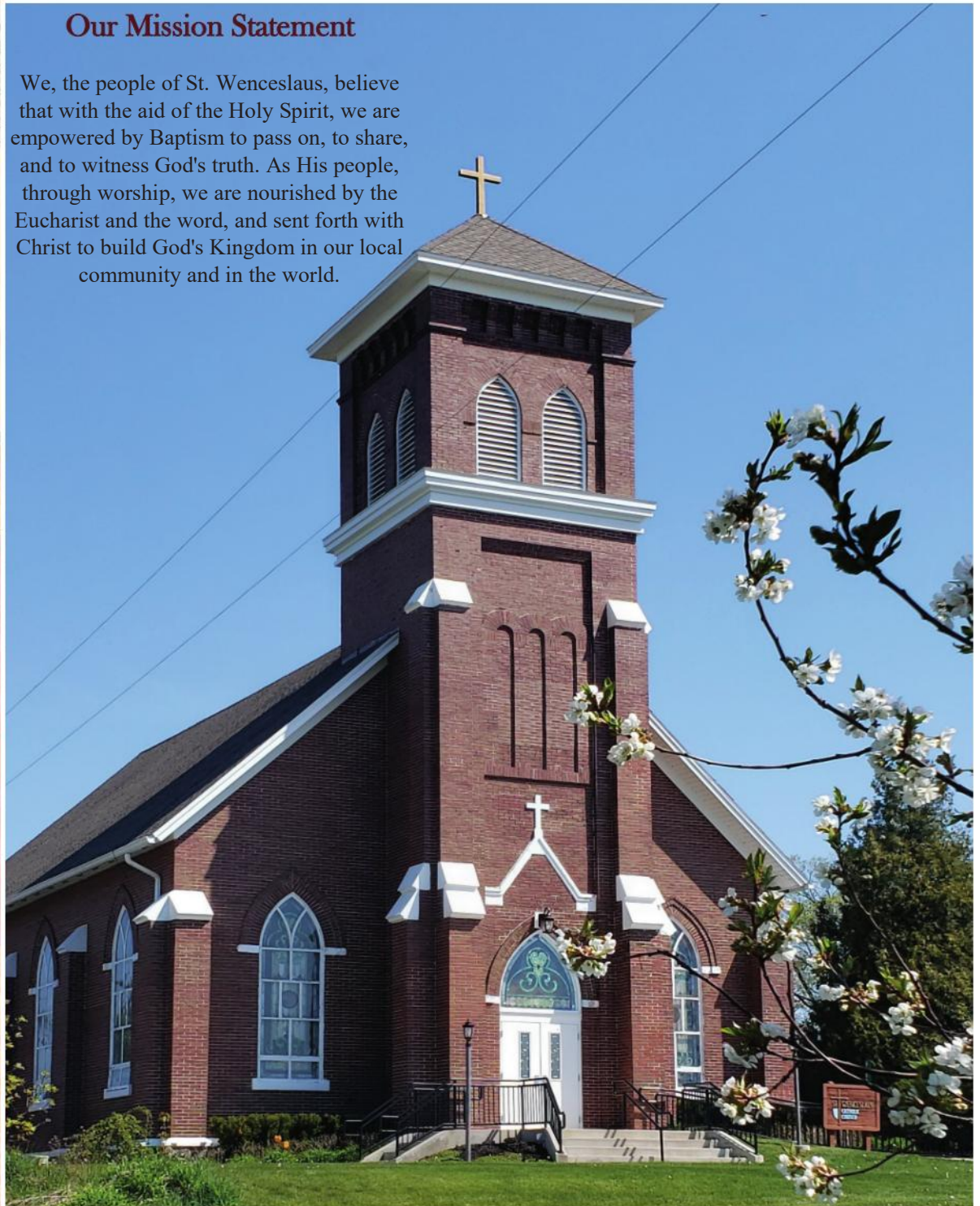

Dear fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. In today's Gospel, John 6:51-58, Jesus tells us that He is the bread of life. It is by eating and drinking His body and blood and believing in Him that we will have eternal life, and He will raise us up on the last day. Jesus spells it out for us. We must receive the body and blood of Jesus in the form of bread and wine. God being God, can appear to us in any form He chooses.

God appeared to us as an infant on Christmas. He appeared to the apostles as a grown man. He appeared to many after His resurrection. He appears to us in the bread and wine. Jesus is truly present in the bread and wine. This is how we can consume His flesh and blood. This is what we do when we receive Holy Communion, the Eucharist.

We physically have an encounter with God, Jesus Christ when we receive the Eucharist. He is truly present to us as He was to the apostles. We can have a conversation with Him. We can share out thoughts, our life, our joys and sorrows. He will talk to us if we listen. He wants to be part of our life. He is reaching out to us. We have only to respond to Him in prayer.

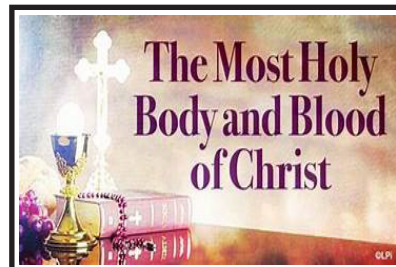

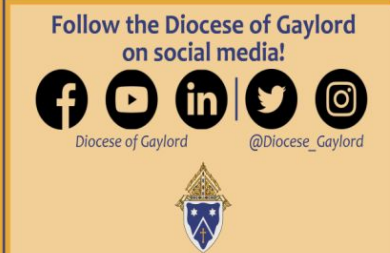
