#### Dear fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Matthew 9:36-10:8, Jesus' heart is moved with pity for the crowd. They were troubled and abandoned like sheep without a shepherd. "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few, so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for His harvest." Then He sent out the twelve Apostles, two by two, to the lost sheep of Israel. 
