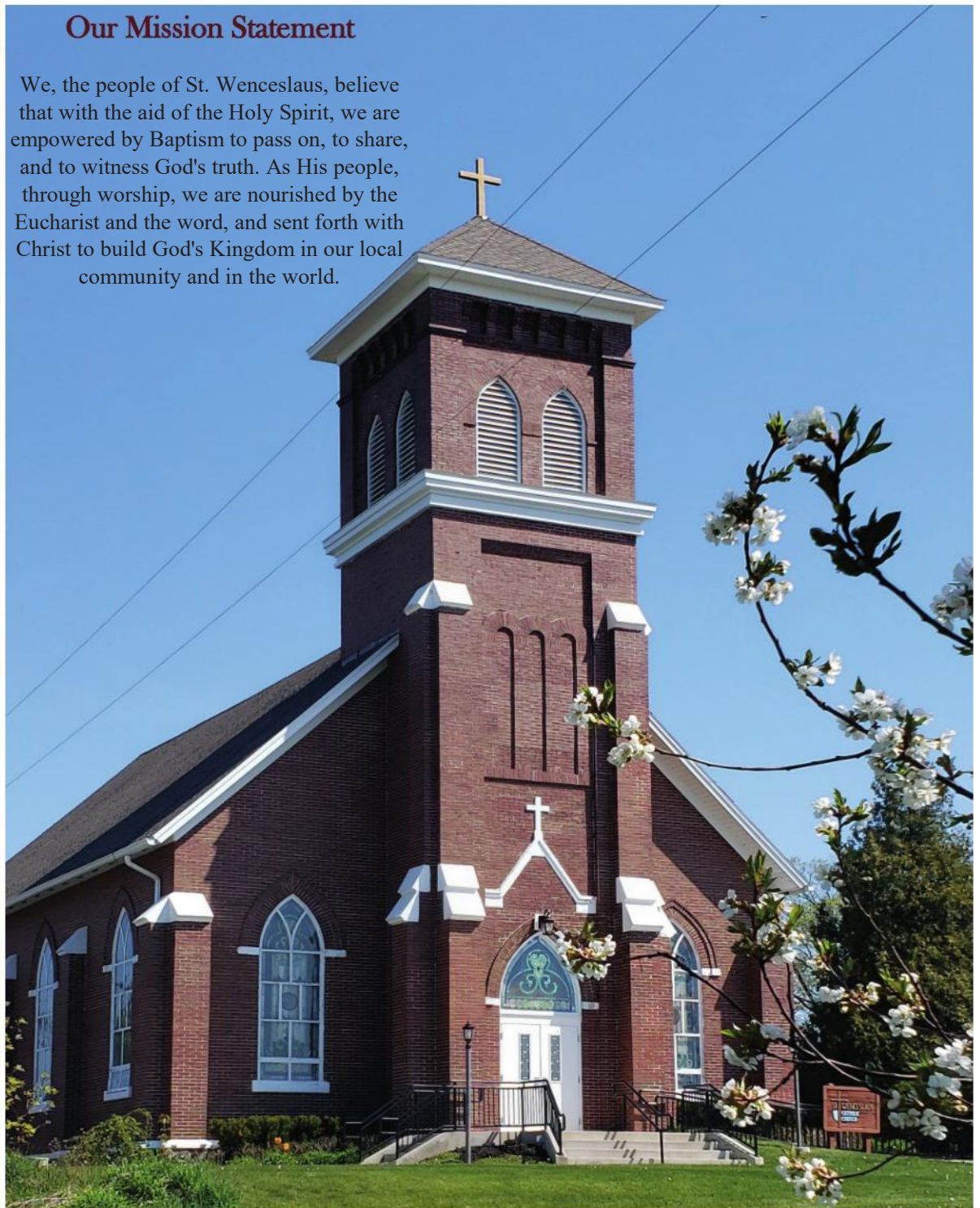




Happy Father's Day

Dear fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Matthew 9:36-10:8, Jesus' heart is moved with pity for the crowd. They were troubled and abandoned like sheep without a shepherd. "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few, so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for His harvest." Then He sent out the twelve Apostles, two by two, to the lost sheep of Israel. Instructing them to proclaim: "The kingdom of heaven is at hand, cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, drive out demons. Without cost you have received, without cost you are to give."

Jesus has pity on all that are troubled and feel abandoned and lost. He has pity on us when we feel alone. He has sent laborers into our life to help us. He sends many people into our lives to comfort us, to console us, to walk with us for awhile, or a long time and share our joys and sorrows. It is with humility that we can accept those who God sends to us.
