

#### Dear fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate The Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Matthew 10:26-33, Jesus tells His disciples not to be afraid. Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul, rather be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna. Are not two sparrows sold for a small coin? Yet not one of them falls to the ground without your Father knowing.

Jesus is telling us that He knows what is happening in our lives. That we are more important than a sparrow. We have value and that we need to trust in God. He is concerned about our welfare, about our soul, about our life into eternity, not just here on earth. He sees the big picture and knows what is best for us.

Jesus tells us three times not to be afraid. We will meet opposition to our faith here on earth. We may be persecuted, lose our job, be shunned, ignored, criticized, or other. We need to have courage and trust in Jesus; He will be faithful to us and acknowledge us before the Father.

We show our trust in Jesus by our prayer life. Our daily communication with Him builds a strong relationship of trust and dependence. This is a life time process, not something we do once and check it off our list. We pray daily with confidence and trust. And so, we are not afraid.
