Today we celebrate the Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Matthew 14:22-33, Jesus' disciples are in a boat being tossed about by the waves. Jesus comes to them walking on the water. The disciples were terrified for they feared it was a ghost. Jesus speaks to them, "Take courage, it is I, do not be afraid." Peter asks to come to Him. 


