### Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Matthew 15:21-28, a Canaanite woman, a non Jew, comes to Jesus asking Him to cure her daughter who is tormented by a demon. Jesus ignores her, and so His disciples ask that He send her away. Jesus states that He came only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

The woman persists. Jesus replies that it is not right to take the food of the children of Israel and throw it to the dogs. She replies, even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their master. Jesus replies, because of your faith, let it be done for you as you wish.

The woman was so concerned for her daughter, that she was even willing to make a humiliating spectacle out of herself, tagging along behind a Jewish rabbi in public, calling out to Him, to get his attention. Her faith comes across in how she addresses Jesus. She calls him "Lord" and "Son of David." This shows that although she was a Canaanite; she knew about the Jewish religion and accepted God's promise to send a Messiah. And when he finally stops to listen to her, she falls on her knees and does him homage - she knows she is in God's presence. She believed in Jesus, so much so, in fact, that Jesus himself compliments her on her faith! Her humility comes across in the way she makes her request. We have much to learn from her.

It is sometimes easier to display our faith among family, friends, and other Christians. In a safe setting, we can be bold in our belief. It is easier to love our friends than an outsider. It can be a challenge to love a stranger. It can be difficult to humble our selves, to admit we need another's help, that maybe I don't know the solutions.


Like the Canaanite woman, we must approach Jesus with humility, with faith, and love of God. He wants us to reach out to Him, with confidence, and acceptance of His help. To reach out to Him in faith, trust and love. Do we have the faith of the Canaanite woman? If not, why not?
