

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Twenty- Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Matthew 22:1-14, Jesus tells the chief priest and elders another parable. The Kingdom of Heaven may be likened to a king who gave a wedding feast for his son. He invited guests, but they refused to attend. He sent servants a second time saying: The banquet is ready, please come. Some went away, others to their business, or mistreated them, even killing the messenger. The King was enraged. He sent his troops to destroy those murderers and burn their city.

Then the King sent his servants to go out and invite whomever they find. The hall was filled with both good and bad, the hall was filled with guests. The King noticed one guest was not wearing a wedding garment. He questioned him, but he remained silent. The King told his attendants to throw him out into the darkness where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth. Many are invited, but few are chosen.

God invites us to his heavenly feast, but not all of us accept His grace, His gracious invitation. All are invited, but not all accept the invitation. Those who refuse the invitation will not be forced into heaven against their will. We must choose it freely. We must also wear a wedding garment. Jesus is the wedding garment; He is our ticket to the banquet. Without Him there is no entering the banquet. We will be left outside. Many are invited, but few are chosen. Will we be among the chosen? Will we accept Jesus as our wedding garment?


