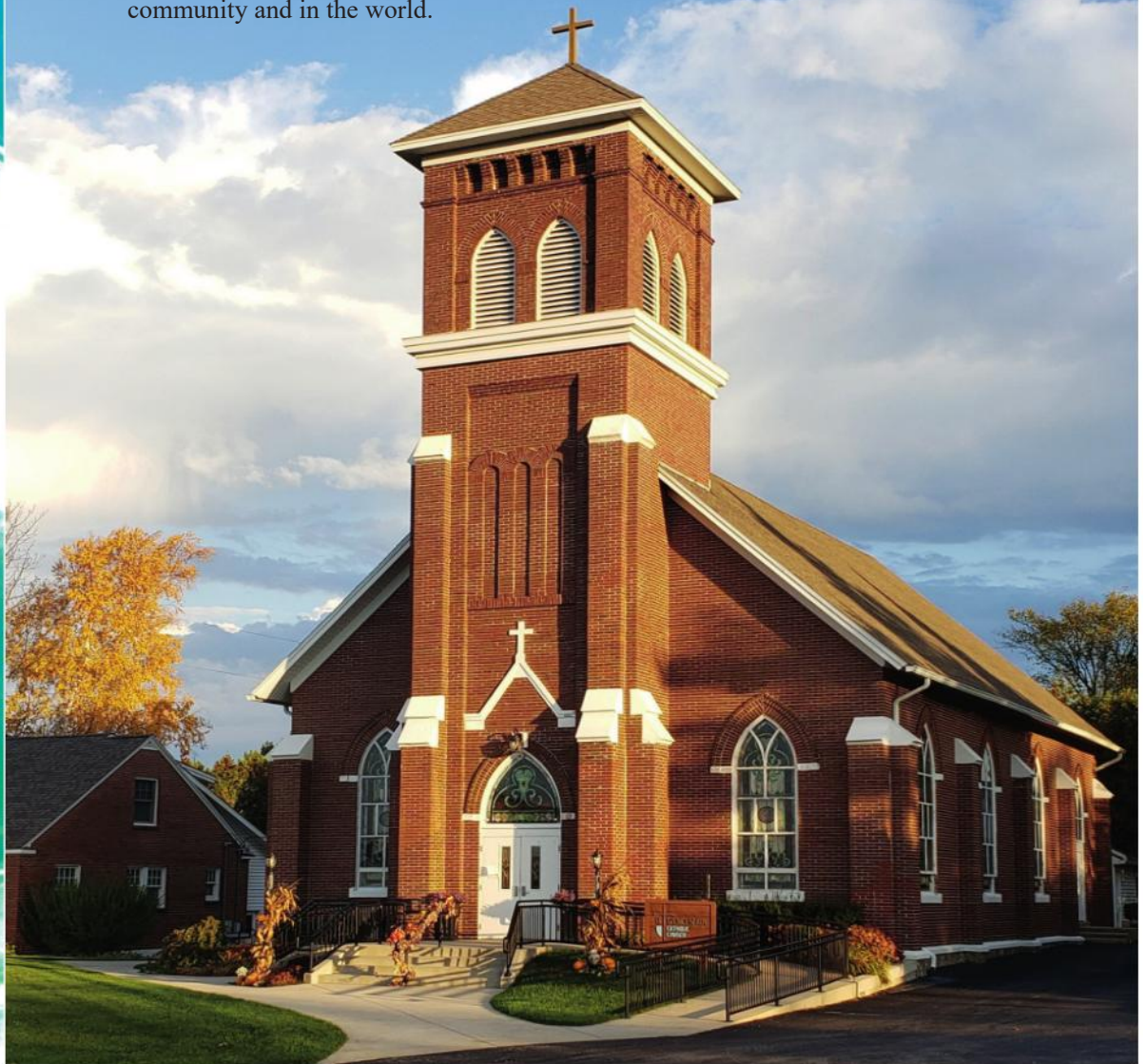

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Twenty Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Matthew 22:15-21, the Pharisees ask Jesus if it is lawful to pay taxes to Caesar? Jesus' response is to look at a coin, who's image is on the coin. The Pharisees answer with Caesar. Jesus tells them to render to Caesar what is Caesar's, and to God what is God's.

We recognize what belongs to Caesar by paying taxes for roads, fire services, schools, sales tax, police protection, and many other taxes. We may complain about it, but we still pay them, we pay Caesar.

Jesus asked who's image is on the coin? In Genesis we learn that God made man in His image. As the coin was made in Caesar's image, so are we made in God's image. Being made in God's image, Jesus is saying we belong to God. We pay what Caesar deserves for what he does for us and God what he deserves for what He gives us.

God gave us our existence, our life, a million big and little pleasures and joys, and our salvation from sin and death and hell. God has given us everything we have and more than we are aware of. Because of this we owe him our gratitude, our affection, our appreciation, our time, our worship, our very selves. Are we giving to God what is God's?
