Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Matthew 23:1-12, Jesus speaks to the crowds and to His disciples, saying, "The scribes and Pharisees have taken their seats on the chair of Moses. Therefore do and observe all things whatsoever they tell you, but do not follow their example."

In today's readings, we're reminded that our receptivity to a message should not be determined by our esteem or scorn for the messenger, but by whether that message is true. When we are the messengers, we must also remember that anything we do to contradict the message hinders even the truest things we try to share.

We have all heard someone say that they left the church because they were offended by someone within the church. It may have been a priest, the secretary, an employee of the church, or even a parishioner. They preach and do not live the message. There are flawed people in the Church. We are to follow Jesus and not the example of some bad leaders. Flawed leaders should not be the bar that we use to measure ourselves. We are to follow the message, not the example of messenger.

Jesus is telling us we are to live by His message passed down by the Church. We are to live by His commandments, love God and love our neighbor. Treat people with respect, dignity, and in a humane way. Listen to others, acknowledge their presence, walk with them and wish the best for them. And above all pray, love God, and follow Jesus' example and message.




