Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, Matthew 25:14-30, Jesus tells his disciples a parable about a man going on a journey. He calls in his servants and entrusts his possessions to them. To one he gives five talents, to another two talents, and to a third he gives one. Each to his ability. The one with five talents invests and gains five more. The one with two does the same and gains two more. The third buries his one, gaining nothing.

When the man returns, he asks for an accounting of his servants. The ones who doubled their talents he rewarded with greater responsibilities. The one who buried his talent, lost the one he had, and was thrown into the darkness outside.

God is the master. We are His servants. To each of us He gives special talents. They are a gift. We do not earn them, we do not deserve them, there is no reason why God gives them to us except that He loves us. We may develop our talents. We are to use them for the building of the Kingdom. We may share them with others. But they are not for our personal use.

Any good that we may do, is because God has given us the talent to begin with. We cannot take credit for any of our achievements. People may praise us for what we do, but God has given us the time, the place, and the talent to build our dream, to assist and help others. Our ability to do well is a gift from God. Always remember they are Gifts from God, freely given, not our personal doings. Thank Him for His "Gifts".


