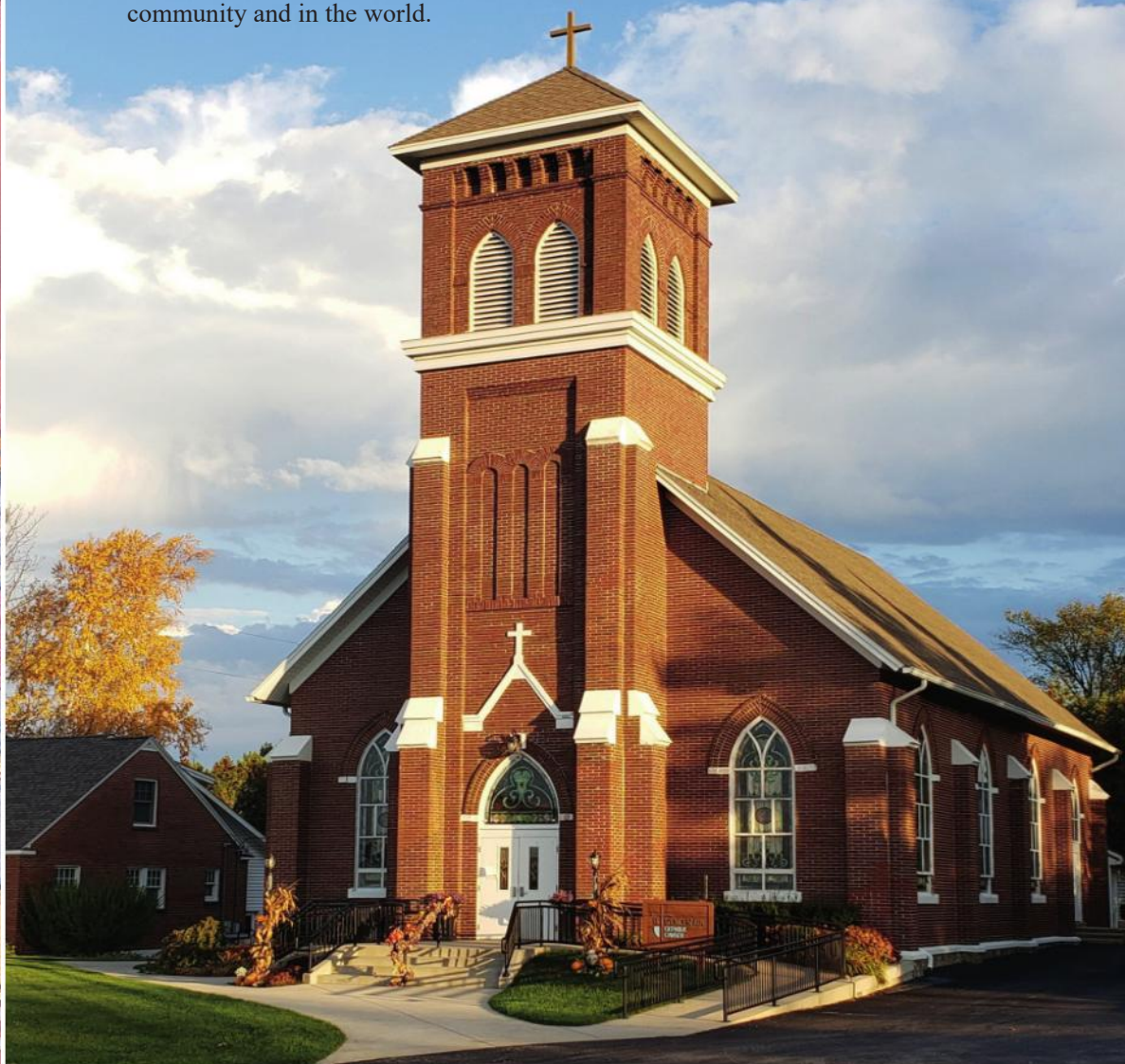




## Our Mission Statement

### Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Today we celebrate Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. In today's Gospel, Matthew 25:34-46, Jesus tells His disciples what will happen when the Son of Man comes in His Glory. As the good Shepherd, He will separate the sheep from the goats, the sheep on His right and the goats on His left. To the ones on His right He tells them: "Come, you who are blessed by my Father. Inherit the Kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. You cared for Me when I was hungry, thirsty, a stranger, naked, in prison, or ill. You did this when you did it to the least of my brothers." To the ones on His left who did none of these things, He tells them, "Depart from Me, you accursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels."

In the end of time, God will be the judge of us all. He will determine whether we have followed His commandments, how well we cared for our neighbor. He tells us what is expected of us, the corporal works of mercy. The choice is ours as to whether we participate in performing these acts of kindness to others.

God who is Lord of the Universe, will determine, will judge us, as how well we know God. That is, having personal knowledge of Him, a personal acquaintance, a personal relationship with Him. This is demonstrated by prayer and how we treat others, how we perform the Corporal Works of Mercy. We are our brother's keeper. God is both just and merciful. It is good to have the person who is to judge us, as our friend.

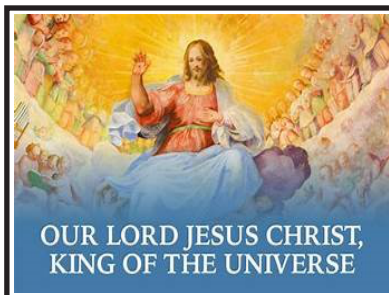
